

## ***Climate Change – Apocalypse? Apparition? - or Admonition for National Repentance and Revival Apocalypse?***

Is ‘Climate Change’ the ‘Apocalypse Now’ of the 21<sup>st</sup> century? This internationally acclaimed Australian environmental scientist says yes.

From *The Weather Makers*, by Tim Flannery, The Text Publishing Company, 2005, ISBN 1-920885-84-6.

*“Prior to 1800 (the start of the Industrial Revolution) there were about 280 parts per million of CO<sub>2</sub> in the atmosphere, which equates to around 586 billion tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub>... Today the figures are 380 parts per million or around 790 billion tonnes... p 28*

*“CO<sub>2</sub> that humans have liberated by burning fossil fuels [since the Industrial Revolution]... is the cause – directly and indirectly – of around 80% of all global warming... p 28*

*“The energy we liberate when we burn these fuels comes from carbon and hydrogen. Because carbon causes climate change [via global warming], the more carbon-rich a fuel is, the more danger it presents to humanity’s future... p 70*

*“If we do not reduce our emissions of greenhouse gases... an increase of 3°C (give or take 2°C) [in the overall surface temperature of the Earth] over the twenty-first century seems inevitable... p 59*

*“Cities will... begin to die when [climate change via global warming] overwhelms the capacity of their networks to supply the essentials. This may occur through the repeated battering of extreme weather events, rising seas and storm surges, extreme cold or heat, water deprivation or flood, or even disease... p 207*

*“Crops will be stressed by higher temperature... a CO<sub>2</sub>-rich world promises to be one in which crop production is lower than today... p 207*

*“Human health, water and food security are now under threat from the modest amount of climate change that has already occurred [via global warming from manmade CO<sub>2</sub> emissions]. If humans pursue business-as-usual for the first half of this century, I believe the collapse of civilisation due to climate change becomes inevitable...” p 209.*

### ***Apparition?***

But not all researchers agree with Flannery. From *Goddess Earth*, by investigative journalist Samantha Smith, Huntington House Publishers, 1994, ISBN1-56384-064-2, p 49:

*“The fact is that when the earth has warmed a little bit, the amount of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere follows along behind the warming. It does not precede it and, therefore, could not be the cause.”* Samantha Smith’s statement has independent confirmation, emphases in original.

*“As illustrated in this chart of Ice Core data from the Soviet Station Vostok in Antarctica, CO<sub>2</sub> concentrations in Earth’s atmosphere move with temperature.”* That is, not the other way around. See [thenewalexandrialibrary.com/co2.html](http://thenewalexandrialibrary.com/co2.html).

Moreover, *“Climate change is controlled primarily by cyclical eccentricities in Earth’s rotation and orbit, as well as variations in the sun’s energy output.*

*““Greenhouse gases” in Earth’s atmosphere also influence Earth’s temperature, but in a much smaller way. Human additions to total greenhouse gases play a still smaller role, contributing about 0.2% - 0.3% to Earth’s greenhouse effect.”*

*“Approximately 99.72% of the “greenhouse effect” is due to natural causes - mostly water vapor and traces of other gases, which we can do nothing at all about. Eliminating human activity altogether would have little impact on climate change.”*

*“Human activities contribute slightly to greenhouse gas concentrations through **farming, manufacturing, power generation, and transportation**. However, these emissions are so dwarfed in comparison to emissions from natural sources [95% from water vapour of natural origin] we can do nothing about, that even the most costly efforts to limit human emissions would have a very small - perhaps undetectable - effect on global climate.”*

(Flannery, p 70, states that CO<sub>2</sub> “acts as a trigger” for global warming by means of water vapour but does not give a straightforward explanation of why this is so.)

Douglas V. Hoyt is a solar physicist and climatologist of 40 years’ standing. He stated in 1997, “[Assuming] the climate is equally sensitive to solar and greenhouse gas forcing, which is customarily assumed, but is probably not strictly true - there are good reasons to believe climate is more sensitive to solar forcing than to greenhouse gas forcing - ...A doubling of greenhouse gases [from 300 to 600 ppm since 1880] will probably cause a global warming between 0.5 and 0.9 C. Since 60% of the warming should have already have occurred, the remaining 40% of the warming will be between 0.2 and 0.4 C [i.e. roughly 10-20% of Flannery’s estimate], which will occur over the next 70 years. This warming is equivalent to about 0.03 to 0.06 C/decade. The rate of change is less than previous climate changes; its total magnitude is small; and ecological systems can adapt as they have in the past.”

*“The two most important factors in causing climate change are solar luminosity increases [attributable in large part to changes in sunspot decay rates and sunspot structure] and the decreased number of explosive volcanic eruptions, which together can explain about 80% of the warming seen since 1880. The other 20% of the variation is caused by a combination of miscellaneous climate forcings and measurement errors. There is no need to invoke increases in carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases as major factors in climate change in the past, nor is there any solid evidence to indicate they will play a major role in future climate change.*

*“The solar luminosity variations can be reconstructed to about 300 AD. Since 1000 AD these luminosity variations and climate have paralleled each other closely, although more work is required to reconstruct climate variations accurately. Since the mid-1960’s the sun has warmed. So has the Earth. Additional factors leading to a warming in surface thermometer measurements are the urban heat island effect, increases in greenhouse gases, and possible changes in sulfate and carbon aerosols. [But] much of the recent global warming can be explained by warming of the sun.”*

In sum, however, the scientists clearly fall into two opposing camps. Crucially, the child of God must ask: *“What saith the scripture?”* Romans 4:3a.

### ***Admonition for National Repentance and Revival***

The scientific controversy notwithstanding, the child of God should never forget that ***“the earth is the Lord’s, and the fulness thereof”*** 1 Corinthians 10:26, including its climate, which is why God says to Noah ***“While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease”*** Genesis 8:22.

But the Lord is at liberty to disrupt this stable rhythm, for the purpose of national repentance, because of:

***“Fire and hail; snow and vapour; stormy wind fulfilling his word...Beasts, and all cattle; creeping things, and flying fowl”*** Psalm 148:8, 10. And therefore:

***“If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land”*** 2 Chronicles 7:13, 14.

This is what one discerning, bible-believing, independent American Baptist evangelist, Dr Sam Gipp, has said about just one aspect of his nation’s ***“wicked ways,”*** this writer’s underlining. See [samgipp.com/essays/?page=61.htm](http://samgipp.com/essays/?page=61.htm).

*“Here are the groups that are actively helping...Muslim murderers to take over our country:*

1. ***The News Media:*** They support anyone who hates this nation and seeks its destruction.
2. ***Public Schools:*** They are run by the liberal NEA [National Education Association] and want every child in America destroyed.
3. ***Liberal Judges:*** They overthrow the will and the good of the people to help destroy America.
4. ***Hollywood:*** They promote pro-Muslim, anti-Christian programming.
5. ***Politicians:*** The Democrats actively support the destruction of America while the Republicans are too cowardly to take any stand they think will hurt them politically.
6. ***Cowards:*** Who are intimidated into silence by their television sets.

*“The worship of false gods violates God!*

*“This nation has seen nothing but drought, wildfires, hurricanes, tornadoes, industrial collapse, and other catastrophes because of our national, cowardly cow-towing to false religions.”*

Besides Islam, the same applies for all other false religions, e.g. consumerism, materialism, humanism, ecumenism, Romanism, multiculturalism, scholarship-onlyism (i.e. ‘correcting’ the 1611 Authorized Holy Bible) *and environmentalism*. Concerning the need for national repentance therefore, in our own nations, ***“Is there not a cause?”*** 1 Samuel 17:29.

Yes, there is. The essentials of national repentance for a nation like Britain are set out as follows.

Though illustrative of God’s righteous judgement on the ***“wicked ways”*** of any nation and the results of national repentance, 2 Chronicles 7:13, 14 relate explicitly to the land of Israel, ***“A land which the LORD thy God careth for: the eyes of the LORD thy God are always upon it, from the beginning of the year even unto the end of the year”*** Deuteronomy 11:12. The essentials of national repentance and revival for Britain are instead encapsulated in a national return to one Book, ***“the royal law”*** James 2:8, the 1611 Authorized King James Holy Bible by which this nation’s governance is determined according to the Coronation Oath, which is a solemn national covenant with Almighty God.

2 Kings 23:1-3 show how a return to *“the royal law”* James 2:8 should be implemented both royally and nationally, most likely at a recognized place of national worship such as Westminster Abbey and televised to the Houses of Parliament and nationwide. The application this time is for *any* nation such that *“If that nation, against whom I have pronounced, turn from their evil, I will repent of the evil that I thought to do unto them”* Jeremiah 18:8.

**“And the king sent, and they gathered unto him all the elders of Judah and of Jerusalem. And the king went up into the house of the LORD, and all the men of Judah and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem with him, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the people, both small and great: and he read in their ears all the words of the book of the covenant which was found in the house of the LORD. And the king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all their heart and all their soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the covenant.”**

The same can also apply to *individual* repentance, as this timely reminder from Jack Chick makes clearly, according to God’s impending judgement worldwide that includes *real* global warming.

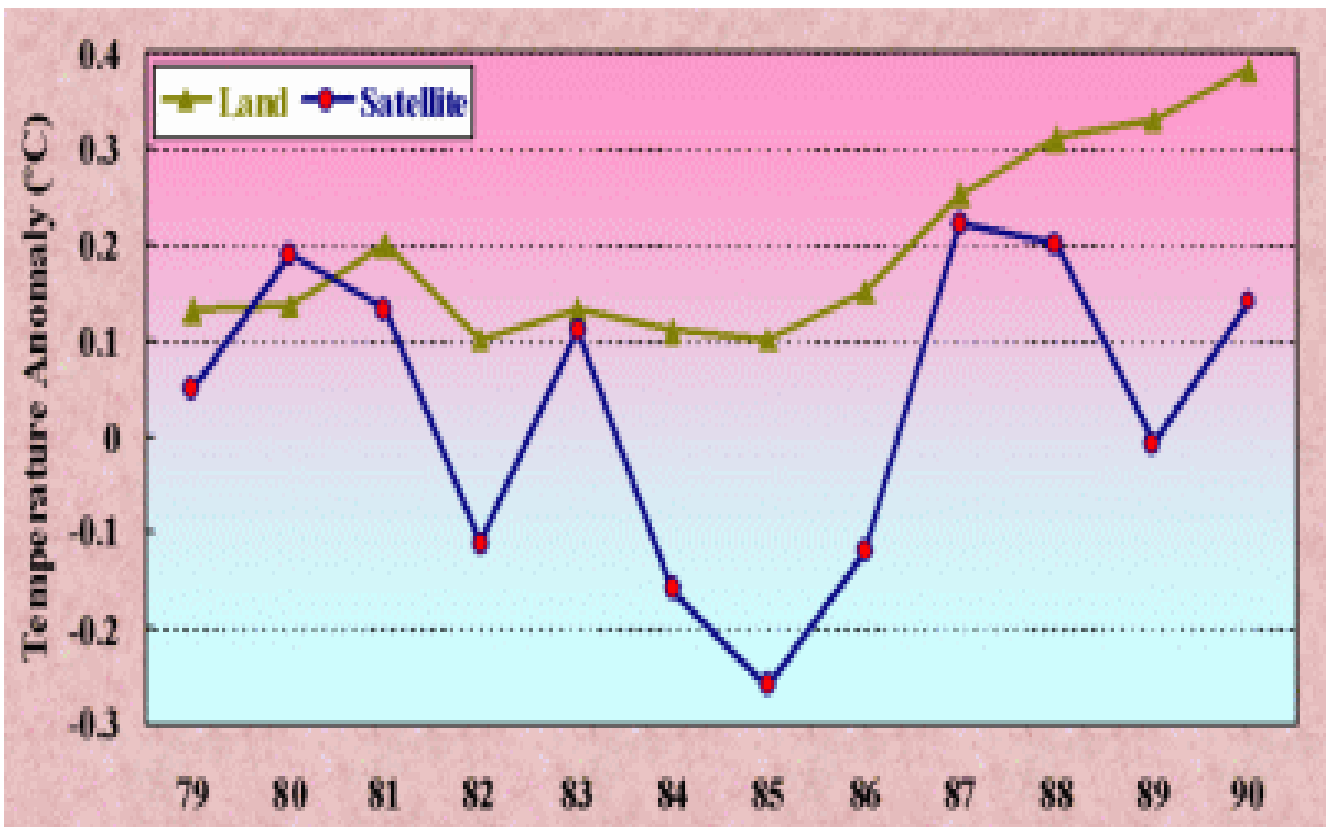

As Measured by NOAA Satellites

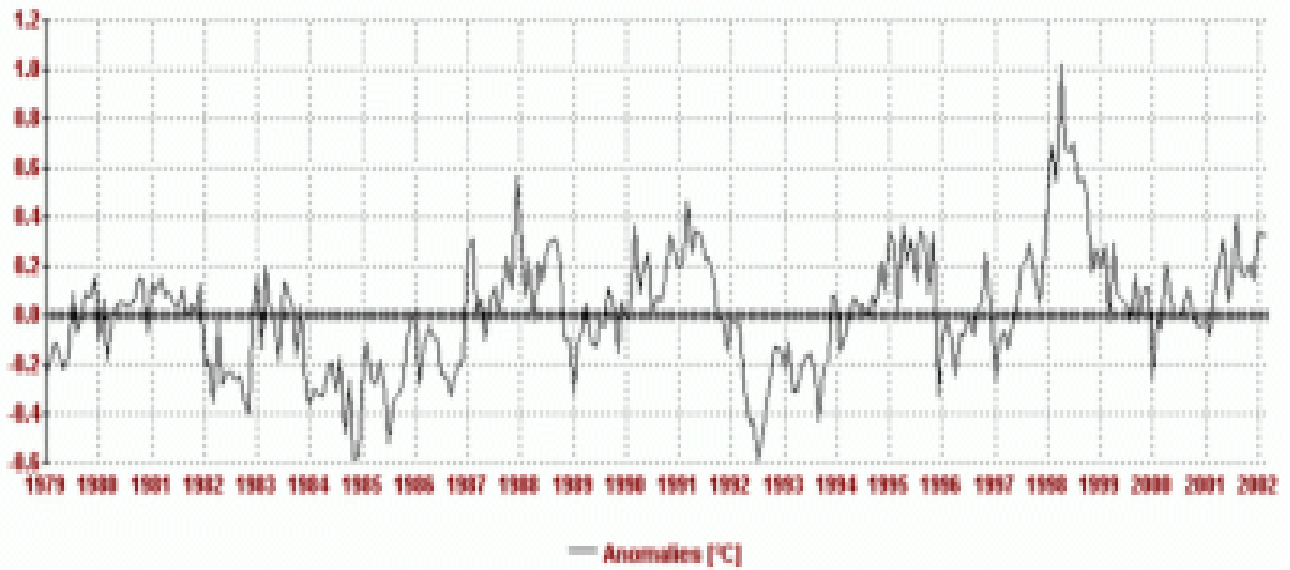
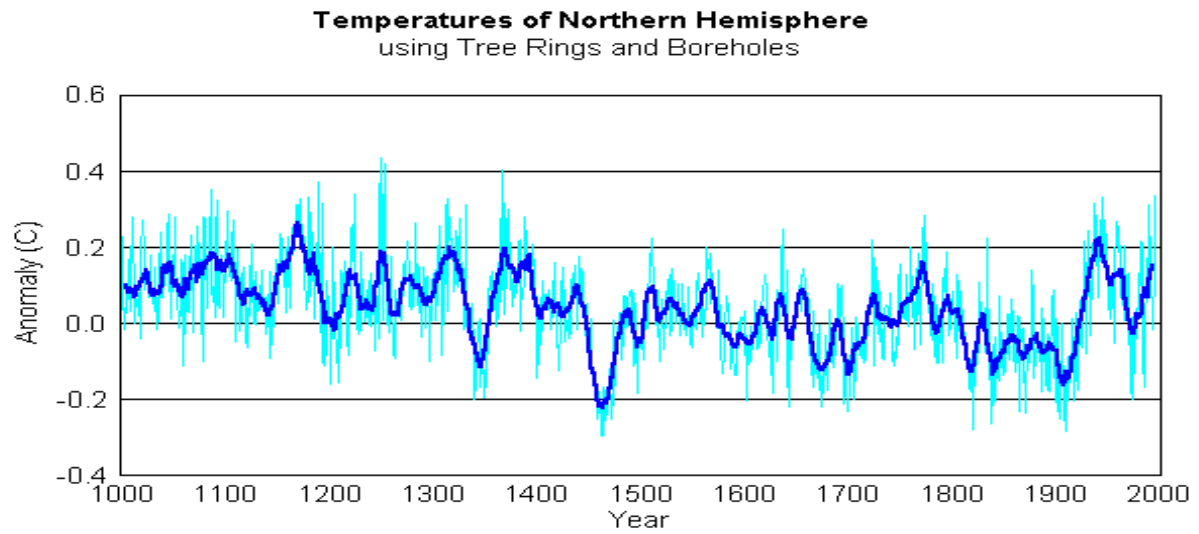


Figure 2: Northern Hemisphere Temperatures 1979-2002

## Annual Global Temperature Departures (1999 value based on 8 month mean)

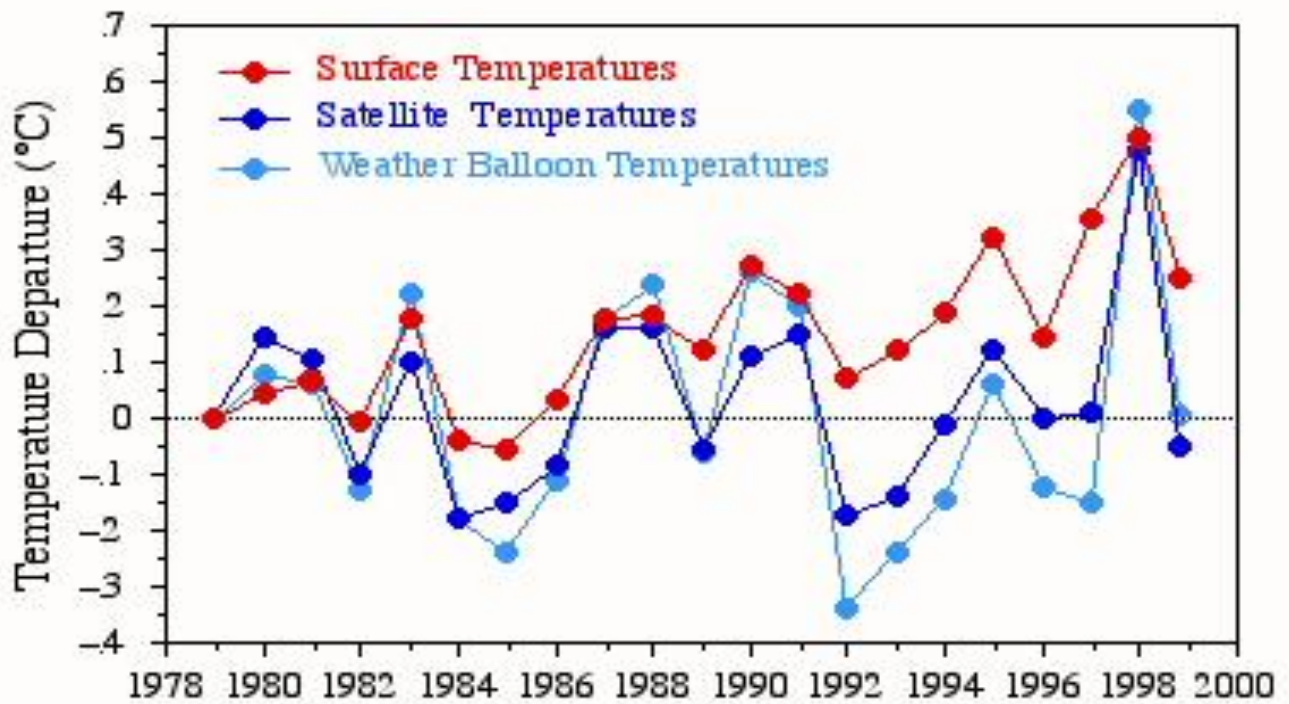
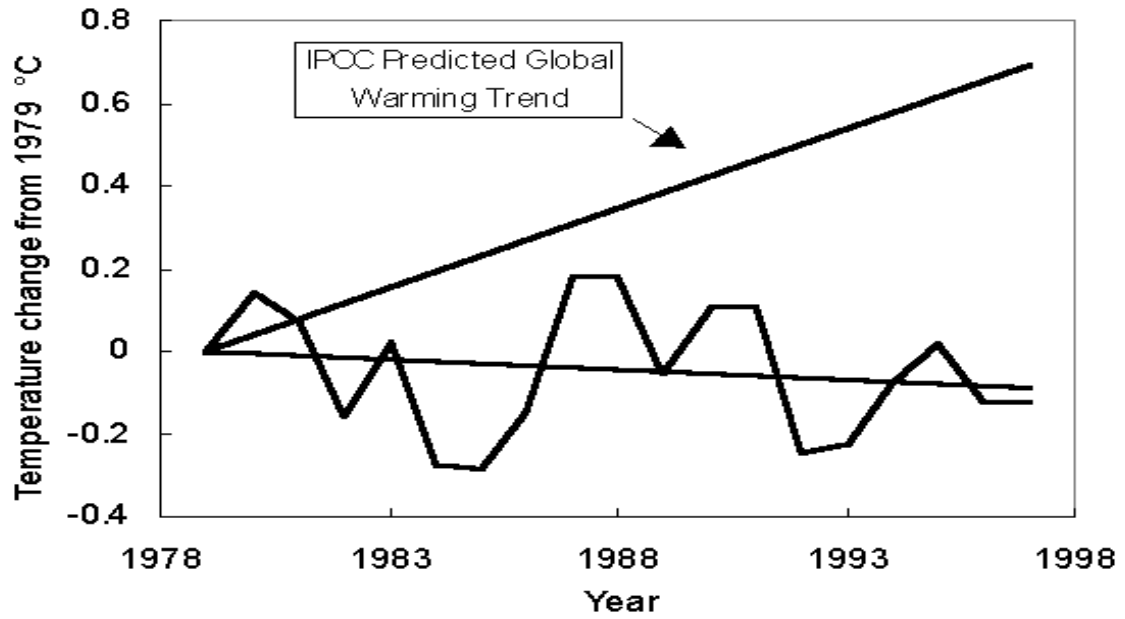
