Mt 5:22 But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his <u>brother without a</u> <u>cause</u> shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, <u>shall be in danger of hell fire.</u> (KJV)

But I say to you that whoever is angry with his brother without a cause<sup>[a]</sup> shall be in danger of the judgment. And whoever says to his brother, 'Raca!' shall be in danger of the council. The good man out of the good treasure brings forth good things; and the wicked man out of the wicked treasure brings forth wicked things. (DBY)

The good man out of his good treasure brings out good things, and the evil man out of his evil treasure brings out evil things. (WEB)
