We are very thankful to the Lord for giving us such a great day. One lady from Barry's church called Val has written the following...

(In time honoured tradition, we pulled up to the conference just in time to grab the last remaining seats, even though we were not the last to show up! The people just kept coming! The Time for Truth! team made each and every one of us welcome, comfortable and well provided for in every way, we wanted for nothing. An opening prayer followed by a hymn and Bible reading led us onto our host John Davis telling us about the history of TfT! Then it was onto our first study of the day, 'the return of Jesus Christ!' Prizes were given out for turning to, & reading aloud the Scriptures. Alan O'Reilly was the quest speaker, & his study was on the differences in the AV cf. NIV regarding salvation! 
Carrying burdens throughout our life!

Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ. For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.

Now there's a question! In my own life there are quite a few things I'd like to change; I'd like a better relationship with my dad, starting with his salvation of course! O that head covering!

Christians get *hung-up* on all kinds of things, most of which are not really that important, yet they make mountains out of mole-hills! The head covering is one of those issues TODAY! The Brethren with all their legalistic religious rituals make a huge thing out of a woman wearing a hat! One elder from a Brethren Assembly we used to attend said that the head covering was the most important doctrine in Scripture because it was all about authority! He obviously never used to read his Bible much did he? Par for the course! The Brethren Assemblies are dying out like many denominations today. Another one closes in Scotland this month where Callum lives! It is very sad, but who wants to sit under dull, legalistic preaching from the JND PERVERTED Bible...? NOT ME that's for sure! Even Calvinism is working its way through this man made denomination! John Darby was a great student of the word but an idiot when he translated the Bible! Enough said, otherwise the wack-heads at the Kingston Bible Trust in London will be after me for attacking their hero 'again!' So let's clear this little problem up once & for all shall we?... Read 1 Cor 11v1-16. Much of this info has been taken from Ruckman's commentary on Corinthians, which I would highly recommend!

In regards to v2 ...**keep the ordinances, as I delivered them to you**. Most preachers teach that there are two ordinances observed by the local church – Believer's Baptism & the Lord's Supper. The hyper-dispensationalists insist that water baptism is NOT an ordinance, & the more radical (e.g. Bullinger) also eliminate the Lord's Supper as an ordinance, although that is the context of 1 Cor 11v17-27. But the hyper-dispensationalists have many weird slants on Scripture, another being the eradication of the doctrine of 'repentance!' Watch out for these heretics as most are very arrogant numbskulls who love the sound of their own voices too much! You'll read about one total wack-head called Richling a little later on! Thank God we don't have many 'hypers' over here in the UK, although we have a great deal of hyper-Calvinists, which are equally heretical! Anyway, back to our study! The haircuts/head-covering in this chapter is NOT an ordinance, so the Scriptural problem is why there is more than 'one' ordinance (he said 'ordinances') The Roman Catholics convert this to 'sacraments!'

'Ordinances' refers to 'ceremonies' in modern language! The only ceremony in the chapter is the Lord's Supper, NOT the head covering! The only two ceremonies mentioned in Scripture are the Lord's Supper & Baptism (Luke 22v19+20, Mat 28v19). This is why Baptists teach TWO offices i.e. bishops, *also-called pastors & elders*, & deacons! They also teach TWO ordinances, i.e. The Lord's Supper & Baptism! Ordinances are also listed in Col 2v20, & these refer neither to Baptism or the Lord's Supper! They are rules & regulations of an Old Testament (OT) nature. Ordinances are mentioned more than fifty times in the OT! The ordinances in 1 Pet 2v13 are commandments (rules & regulations to be obeyed – Rom 13v2) The best conclusion is that Acts 15v28-31 is part of the 'ordinances' that Paul delivered, along with two 'ceremonies' – the Lord's Supper & Baptism! Since the GOSPEL is the DEATH, BURIAL & RESURRECTION (1 Cor 15v1-4) TWO ordinances would show that! The Lord's Supper shows the Lord's DEATH & Baptism shows the Lord's BURIAL & RESURRECTION! So now let's look at the head covering...

1 Cor 11v4 **Every man praying or prophesying, having his head covered, dishonoureth his head**. Indicating that when a man prays he should take off his hat! The idea is that Christ is man's HEAD! In other words, in type, there should NOT be anything between the man & Christ, as Jesus Christ is the HEAD!

1 Cor 11v5 But every woman that prayeth or prophesieth with her head uncovered dishonoureth her head: for that is even all one as if she were shaven. So when a woman prays or prophesies, she is to have some covering on her head. If she doesn't have a covering on her head, it is just the same as if her hair was all shaved off! The woman should wear a hat UNLESS she has LONG HAIR! Look at v15 But if a woman have long hair, it is a glory to her: for her hair is given her for a covering.

1 Cor 11v6 For if the woman be not covered, let her also be shorn: but if it be a shame for a woman to be shorn or shaven, let her be covered. If a woman will NOT keep her head COVERED either by a hat or by LONG HAIR, then Paul says cut off all of her hair - let her also be shorn.

1 Cor 11v7 For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, forasmuch as he is the image and glory of God: but the woman is the glory of the man. This verse contains two very important points! The first is DOCTRINAL, & the other is PRACTICAL! Doctrinally, note what the Lord says about the saved man... 'forasmuch as he is the image... of God' That saved man has regained what Adam lost! (Listen to our CD study on the Image of Christ!) Adam was made in the image of God (Gen 1v27). When he sinned, the part of him that died was his spirit, the part that communed with God (Eph 2v1, Rom 8v16). The image that God made (Gen 2v7) was marred! Notice that Seth was NOT born 'in the image of God', but 'after his (Adam's) image' (Gen 5v2). We sin because we are IN Adam (Rom 5v19); we die because we are IN Adam (1 Cor 15v22, Rom 5v17). But when a man receives Christ as his Saviour, he is no longer 'in Adam', he is now IN Christ! (1 Cor 12v13+27, Eph 5v30) Moreover, Christ is IN YOU (Col 1v27) in the Person of the Holy Ghost (Rom 8v9-16). When God looks at a saved man, He does NOT see a sinner in Adam's image, but His own Son who IS 'the image of God' Himself (2 Cor 4v4, Heb 1v3) The question arises... 'What about the fact that we are still in a sinful body?' That is the purpose behind spiritual circumcision: to DIVIDE the OLD Adamic nature in the flesh FROM the NEW MAN IN Christ Jesus (Col 2v11-13 + 3v10) The added bonus is that someday God will change that sinful body & adopt it into His family too – Phil 3v21, 1 Cor 15v50-54, Rom 8v23-29.

Practically speaking, v7 shows that any time a country begins to *worship* women or *magnify* & *glorify* women, it destroys itself! Rom 1v23 And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man... You are told that man (from the standpoint of the original creation, cf. vs8+9) 'is the image and glory of God: but the woman is the glory of the man.' So when a nation begins to *magnify* women they are magnifying *man's glory*, NOT God's glory! That is the beginning of THE END! Just look at the TV, internet, billboards, posters, magazines etc. they are saturated in LUSTFUL WOMEN who are being magnified/worshipped! 'The woman is the glory of the man.' When the women are being magnified, that is MAN bragging on his own glory & NOT God's! The Christian man deals with temptation constantly in this lustful-sinful-perverted world we live in! Much of the music, film & entertainment industry today is pornographic! Hollywood, social media sites like YouTube etc. are kingdoms for Satan, HE runs them & many Christians are caught up in his 'world-wide-WEB – www.!'

Regarding v8+9 note that when Paul wants to affirm the Scriptural authority of the man over the woman, he does not go back to the curse placed upon Eve in Gen 3v16. Instead, he goes back to Gen 2, to the ORIGINAL order & purpose of creation... Adam first, then Eve (v8), Eve FOR Adam, NOT Adam for Eve (v9 cf. Gen 2v18). Man's authority does NOT begin with the result of the curse.

'For this cause...' is associated with what he just said about Adam & Eve in the previous verses! The 'power on her head' matches the covering in v5, 'every woman that prayeth or prophesieth with her head uncovered dishonoureth her head' Her 'head' is defined in v3 'the head of the woman is the man' The connection is that the man is over the woman, & the covering on her head is a symbol of the fact that she is under him & he is over her! Of course this is rejected by the modern day church as they have REJECTED the word of God.

1 Cor 11v10 For this cause ought the woman to have power on her head... Now it can either come as a COVERING, (v5), or else it can come as long hair v15 ...if a woman have long hair, it is a glory to her: for her hair is given her for a covering. The question arises, 'Cover what?' I mean short hair will cover your head. The bible definition of long hair is hair that covers THE NECK! How long is long? If the hair covers the neck it is long hair! v6 says ...if it be a shame for a woman to be shorn or shaven... In other words, there wasn't a hard line laid down on it! There was no hard & fast rule. For example, look at v16 But if any man seem to be contentious, we have no such custom, neither the churches of God. So as far as the woman is concerned, there is no hard & fast rule on it, but as the verse says, if it is a shame for a woman to be shorn or shaven, then let her put a veil or a hat on her head to cover her head! If NOT, then okay, there's no argument on it!

1 Cor 11v10 For this cause ought the woman to have power on her head because of the angels. Again this is a tough verse! There are a couple of different interpretations regarding this. The first is that when a woman does NOT cover her head either with a covering, veil or long hair, then it is a sign that she is in rebellion against authority, & therefore, that reminds the angels of their rebellion against God's authority. That is what most commentators say! The next interpretation is that it is possible for the angels to have 'relationships with women', as they did in Gen 6!?

1 Cor 11v13 Judge in yourselves: is it comely that a woman pray unto God uncovered? Here, Paul appeals to their common sense. 'Does it seem right for a woman to pray uncovered?' That's why the 'power' in v10 is talking about a 'covering' as a veil & NOT just man's authority, because the CONTEXT is still that a woman's hair is for a COVERING! 1 Cor 11v13 Judge in yourselves: is it comely that a woman pray unto God uncovered? Does it look right to see a woman praying to God with NO veil or NO hat, or SHORT HAIR & NOT covered with LONG hair?

1 Cor 11v14 **Doth not even nature itself teach you...** There are some things you know by nature that you don't have to be taught from the Bible! Just *common sense* teaches you! **Doth not even nature itself teach you, that, if a man have long hair, it is a shame unto him?** The question comes up, 'How long is long?' Well, whatever you've got, if it covers the ears

or the neck or the forehead then it's like woman's hair, because a woman's hair is supposed to cover her ears, neck & head! LONG HAIR is given for a COVERING, NOT short hair! Common sense tells you that it is UNNATURAL & a shame for a MAN to have LONG hair! Rom 1v26 For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: See that, AGAINST NATURE! Rom 1v27 And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet. How about these interesting verses...Rev 9v7+8 And the shapes of the locusts were like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads were as it were crowns like gold, and their faces were as the faces of men. And they had hair as the hair of women, and their teeth were as the teeth of lions.

'Nature', that is, 'human nature,' teaches you that it is *natural* for a man to have SHORT hair & a woman to have LONG hair! You don't have to be taught that, it's natural!

I've heard Christians say "Well back in the 1400's, 1500's, 1600's etc. they had LONG hair e.g. John Wesley etc. They even wore wigs like King James did or George Washington etc." But these type of Christians overlook TWO things... 1) There wasn't a barber shop within 10-50 miles oftentimes, let alone on every corner like we have today! 2) Regarding the wigs, like Judges wear, they follow the pattern of Jesus Christ in Rev 1v14 **His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire**; Therefore Judges, Politicians, Lawyers & Kings used to wear a wig as authoritative!

If YOU want to wear long hair, WHY do you want to wear it? It's all about motive, & why you do what you do, for what reason? I get DUMB Christians telling me all the time that it is okay to drink alcohol, they DON'T care what the Scriptures say or teach, they will JUSTIFY WHY they DO IT! (Luke 16v15!!!) At the end of the day, YOU are YOUR own FINAL

AUTHORITY when the rubber *really* hits the road! What does the WORLD do & say regarding men having LONG HAIR, surely that is clue? What kind of hair do Rock Bands have, surely that's a giveaway? Do YOU follow the WORLD or the WORD?

Why did Jesus have LONG HAIR? Read Lev 19v26+27 Ye shall not eat any thing with the blood: neither shall ye use enchantment, nor observe times. Ye shall not round the corners of your heads, neither shalt thou mar the corners of thy beard. These are NOT the regulations given to a Nazarite, they are the regulations given to the WHOLE NATION! Jesus



was an Orthodox Jew under the Law! This is the regulation for every Jew alive! Every Jew alive has to let his hair grow so that you can't see the 'shape of his head' & has to let his beard grow so you can't see the 'shape of his face!' The reason the Lord did this is because it is a SHAME FOR A MAN TO HAVE LONG HAIR, & the JEWS were a peculiar people to BEAR HIS SHAME & HIS REPROACH! The other regulation that is 'contrary' to NATURE which the JEW must do, is be circumcised as a baby! Christ HAD to have LONG HAIR, He was a JEW! If He cut His hair He violated the Law!

1 Cor 11v14 **Doth not even nature itself teach you, that, if a man have long hair, it is a shame unto him?** But with the Jew He has to, YOU are TOLD NOT TO!

1 Cor 11v15 But if a woman have long hair, it is a glory to her: for her hair is given her for a covering. The Scriptures say that the WOMAN'S hair is given her FOR A COVERING! Did you get that, it's HER COVERING! The context of v16 is the WOMAN'S haircut, NOT the MANS! 1 Cor 11v16 But if any man seem to be contentious, we have no such custom, neither the churches of God. Now the Brethren & other 'cults,' like to pull out their legalistic, oppressive, dominating 'Assembly Books' & show you that a woman MUST wear a hat or she is in rebellion! If she wears trousers she is in rebellion! If you haven't been baptised you CAN'T take of the Lord's Supper (they call it the 'breaking of bread', which by doing so, they WREST Scripture to their own destruction! (2 Pet 3v16) The Brethren think that the 'breaking bread' in Acts 2v46 is a reference to the Lord's Supper... THEY ARE NUTS!!! It's talking about Christian fellowship around the meal table!!!) You see many Christians tell me the Brethren are good on DOCTRINE & TEACHING, but to be honest, that is because all the other 'denominations' are so POOR on teaching & doctrine! Most of the Brethren 'assemblies' I've been in are VERY shallow when it comes to the DEPTH of Scripture! They love to write little 'letters' to their other little 'cult' assemblies verifying whether the visiting brother is 'allowed' to 'break bread' (The Lord's Supper!!!) But when it comes to TEACHING THAT BOOK, they are still in kindergarten! Now that I'm on a roll regarding the Brethren 'cult' I might as well finish off... How many times have you sat in one of their services & have felt that there is more life in a morgue? One brother gets up at 10.30am '& 12 seconds,' & announces the first hymn! It is sung with as much gusto as you get in your local library! After 3 minutes of killing the hymn, you all sit down in silence! Then after 5 minutes of absolute silence, with everyone looking at the clock, 'willing' for the big-hand to move faster, another 'brother' gets up & 'offers' a lifeless reading, oftentimes from a Darby PERVERSION or something equally as SATANIC! I'd better stop now, as I'm enjoying myself too much!!! All I'm saying is this, you & I make choices in life; you can live by THE BOOK, all of the time, some of the time, when it suits, or not at all, it's a free country! Most denominations put their 'constitutions' & 'traditions' (no matter how old) on par or 'above' THE BOOK! Here at Time for Truth! we will NEVER DO THAT! THE BOOK (AV) corrects us & we submit to it! Now if you don't like that, or don't agree with our stand, 'TOUGH APPLES BABY!' You believe what you want to believe & we shall stay with the word of God! I personally have NO RESPECT for ANY Bible 'corrector, rejector, or pervertor', no matter what your man made denomination is! If you want to make your women wear a funny hat, go ahead & be my guest, we've been down that road many times! At The Oaks Church in Harvington, we preach & teach the Scriptures, & you either come in line with THEM, or you can't take it & GET OUT & find yourself a nice little church to take it easy in! MOST Christians I know, want the EASY LIFE, very few want to walk close to the Lord! If you are



The Ministry Years Volume Two!



Amrik's Testimony

One day I was in my local library looking at books on alternative medicines and as I turned from this section I found myself facing the Holy Bible. I reached out to take hold of it and thoughts came rushing to my mind; this is not for me, I have my religion, this is for the West! Then I thought, I've already tried everything else so I'm going to see what the Bible is all about. I started to read the Gospel of John and it made no sense to me. Over the next few weeks I continued going to the library to search the Scriptures and slowly I felt my life changing. One day as I finished reading in the library I put the Bible down and had a strong conviction that the Bible is the word of God. I now knew the Bible contained all the answers to life I was looking for and I had to have a Bible of my own. The following weekend I went to a bookshop and purchased my first Holy Bible, I was so spiritually hungry that within 6 months I had read from Genesis to the Book of Revelation. What a blessed day it was when I read Luke 18 verses 10-14 and got on my knees and confessed that I was a sinner and asked Jesus to save me. "Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican. The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted." Amrik

The GAP FACT!

Toy wrote to Callum recently, as he had asked some questions about the GAP 'theory'... Her response was thus... Hi Callum,

What exactly do you mean by the Gap Theory?

•There is a Gap between Genesis 1v1 and Genesis 1v2 where the earth was inhabited not by humans but by angelic beings.

•This is not a statement that in anyway promotes evolution or an old earth that's billions of years old but just one that says that there was something here before Adam.

Why do you believe the Gap Theory to be true?

•The flood in 2 Peter 3 is not the same as Noah's flood - verse 5 says that the earth was standing out of the water and in the water. "Satan's flood" here in 2 Peter 3 involves the actual earth being submerged in water as opposed to the land. We know that Noah's flood was worldwide and it was the land that was flooded so the two passages cannot be talking about the same thing.

•The planet in Noah's flood was suspended in space (Job 26v7) and not standing out of the water and in it as in "Satan's flood."

•Verse 7 of the same passage in 2 Peter 3 goes onto say "But the heavens and the earth, which are now..." the phrase "which are now" demonstrates that there was a heaven and earth that was before.

•In relation to the pre-Adamic angelic race see Jeremiah 4v26 which talks about cities that were on earth before Adam. As Cain was the first city builder how were there cities before Adam if there was no Gap?

•It is interesting also that God never said that it "was good" on the 2nd day - why? Satan's fall? Flood? Something obviously happened here. This also ties in with the Gap Fact (see Job 22v8-17); the mighty man in the passage here is Satan and the honourable man is Adam. Note also the reference to the flood in verse 16. Satan had the kingdom and God then gave it to Adam, Satan wanted it back and went straight for Eve to get it (cross reference with 2 Corinthians 4v4).

•After Noah's flood, God tells him to replenish the earth (Genesis 9v1) - the earth needed replenishing after the destruction that had just happened. In Genesis 1v28 God says the same thing "replenish the earth" - why would God say this if the earth has just been created perfect. Again this ties in perfectly with the Gap Fact as the earth needed replenishing after the destruction that had taken place.

I have just very quickly gone through some of the notes and cross references in my Bible to type out the above points, so there are undoubtedly a lot of points I've missed, left out or forgotten about but I hope it's of some help to you :)

Taken from Ruckman's Reference Bible!

Dan 4v17 This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men. 'The decree' & 'the demand' are the same thing, just like 'the watchers' & 'the holy ones' are the same! This is a figure of speech known as a 'hendiadys': two nouns joined by a conjunction & referring to the same person, place, or thing! Other examples can be found in Matthew 21v5 & especially Titus 2v13, where 'the great God' & 'Jesus Christ' are the same person!

One of the most important verses in the Bible!

Dan 4v17 This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men. This verse is one of the most important in either Testament: it is one of the definitive verses on the earthly government of the Gentiles. Although Satan is 'the god of this world' (2 Cor 4v4) & the 'prince of this world' (John 14v30) & gives earthly 'power' & 'glory' to whomever he wants (Luke 4v5+6), he can only do that at the permission & direction of God! Here in the OT it is God the Father who is given the credit for setting up & deposing rulers! In the NT, though, that responsibility is given to God the Son, who has been given 'all power... in heaven and in earth' (Mat 28v18) after His resurrection! The NT makes it clear that it is Jesus Christ who gave Nero the power to kill Christians (Rom 13v1-5, 1 Pet 2v13-17).

When was the last time you tried to reach your family members with a Gospel tract? Time is running out folks! The Rapture is imminent & HELL is a reality! Do all you can to reach your family with the Gospel! Don't leave it a moment longer, post a tract today or email them a link to the Gospel!

Pride – it's a KILLER!

Dan 5v20 But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him: Prov 6v16-19 These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: A proud look... Gal 6v3 For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself. Pride keeps you FROM God, it also keeps you from doing God's will! Most Christian men I know are proud; there are very few I have met who have impressed me with their humility. It's as if men try to get 'one-up' on each other, they want to impress you that they know more Scripture than you, or are better than you at something. They get a kick out of 'winning' & putting you down! Some of the most arrogant people I have known have been Christians! Bible colleges seem to have a knack of producing egotistical Christians good for NOTHING - 1 Tim 3v6 Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil. I haven't met a humble Calvinist, Brethren, or Pentecostal, they are as arrogant as you can get! Yet God requires humility, as He wants to work through you. Maybe one reason you are not seeing the Lord's blessing on your life, or you are NOT being used by the Lord, is because you are TOO PROUD! Think about that for a while! Remember, *you can NEVER be too small for God to use, but you can be TOO BIG for Him to use!*

So what are your plans for the future?

Are you content with your life or are you seeking 'more?' Are you pleased with the way you are living for the Lord or are you hardly living for Him at all? How would you feel if you stood before Him at the Judgment today & had to give an account of the way you have lived for Him? *It's coming!*

Helping out your pastor?

Have you ever thought how you could help your pastor more? He carries quite a load you know, much of which you don't often see. He spends hours in the Bible, studying, in order to bring YOU the truth. He spends his time looking after & protecting his sheep. Oftentimes he makes sacrifices regarding his family, his time & money, etc. all because he wants to serve the Lord & the people in the church. *Do you think you could help him in any way*? If so, why not let him know, or send him an anonymous gift, or offer to take some of his workload. Many a pastor I know does nearly everything in the church, including putting out the chairs, greeting folks at the door, etc. If this is the case in your church, why not turn up early & take that job from him? You know what needs to be done & you know who is doing the work; *could you do more? What have YOU sacrificed lately for someone else... your time & money etc.*

Talking OR walking?

Do you 'talk' a good Christian walk, or, do you actually WALK a 'good' walk? How about this for a challenging passage...James 1v22-27 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed. If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain. Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world. Practically speaking, are you a 'doer' of the word & work, or are you good at listening & reading but you just DON'T live out the Christian life you should be? Talk is easy & talk is cheap! Are you a good witness & testimony to your own family, or are you letting them down as well as yourself & ultimately the Lord? Like Tozer said, "You can have as much of God as you want!" Most Christians are happy with a comfortable compromising lifestyle, rather than being totally sold out & given over to serving Jesus Christ with every ounce of strength you have! One is easy to do & one is very difficult, what is your choice?

Hospital 'again!'

It seems as if I have visited the hospital fairly regularly over recent years, & today was just another visit! This time, I went to talk over my future hip operation & recovery. There were about 15 of us in the room & all the different nurses & specialists were there explaining what will happen & how we should recover! I knew nearly every road & country path around the village, & we would take many trips to the river. Life was idyllic, & as a child I had no worries or responsibilities, it was just play all day, every day, when not at school that was! When you hit the 'big school' it is quite a wakeup call & when you leave school, it's often a culture shock! Going back to Oakley brought back some lovely memories for me, but also some sad ones. Then, as a child, I would have no idea that my mum & dad would divorce after 35 years of marriage, or that my mum would die through 'smoking', or that my dad & I would split up & not talk again. I would have no idea then, that later on in my life at the age of 18, I would become a Christian & spend the rest of my life trying to live according to the Scriptures & end up running a small church just outside Kidderminster. Like many boys, I always wanted to be a footballer, & throughout the years, right up until 40, I would put my body through a lot of pain & stress! It was at the age of 40 that I stopped running! Now I have damaged hips with Osteoarthritis in both including my spine. I would never have imagined that one day I would stop running, you just don't think about these things as a child! Summer holidays seemed like an eternity, & worries & responsibilities are just not there. It's funny regarding some of the feelings you have as you grow up, sometimes you feel that you're doing great in life & things are working out well, other times you feel a failure & that you've done very little with your life. Rather than go by feelings, we should abide by the word of God & live it in every part of our lives giving praise & honour to God, thanking Him for every day we wake up to 'life!' My childhood has passed, & I am a man now, I must live for the Lord as a man & focus on the future rather than dwell on things that do not profit. 1 Cor 13v11 When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things. I'm sure we all need to 'man-up' at times & make the best of what we have & if we have opportunities, seize them for the Lord asking Him to guide us every step of the way. Today's world is a far cry from John Wesley's, & although THE BOOK & THE GOSPEL haven't changed, the 'world' has. As we sat there having eaten our cheese salad sandwich & drinking our tea, along came about 25 people who also ordered sandwiches & drinks & sat around us. Then a guy pulls out an AV Bible & starts flicking through it! We thought, Christians! We did, after telling them THE GOSPEL & that you cannot get to Heaven by doing ANY kind of works including baptism! Their so-called leader kept running back to 'the' Greek (there isn't one, *plus he didn't speak it! None of them ever do!!!*) & he just kept digging a bigger hole for himself. He was a very arrogant, unpleasant man who knew as much Scriptures as was written on the packet of crisps he was eating! These CULT members are so shallow in Scripture, so stubborn in their thinking, & so deceived by MEN, it's amazing! I think we must have ruined their leisurely walk across the Malvern's *I'm pleased to say*, but at least we gave them something to think about, while walking!

David Brainerd - (1718-1747) - (Article taken from GFA)

David Brainerd was born in Haddam, in the County of Herford, Connecticut, on April 20, 1718. His father, Hezekiah Brainerd, died when David was nine, and his mother, Dorothy, who was the daughter of the Reverend Jeremiah Hobart, died leaving him an orphan when he was 14. His was a strict religious home of the Congregational Church persuasion. Bible reading, prayer, Sabbath observance, and Christian classics such as Bunyan's *Pilgrim's Progress* and Baxter's *A Call to the Unconverted* were the order of the day. But it was not until he was 21, while living in the home of Phinehas Fiske, who was pastor of the Congregational Church at Haddam, that one evening in solitary mediation he saw his lost and helpless condition. It was as though he saw a vision—not external but in the heart—of the glory of God. "I was even swallowed up in Him." A new peace engulfed him. Joy overwhelmed him. He had become a new creature in Christ. He said, "**One hour with God**



infinitely exceeds all the pleasures of this lower world." Even before this experience he had been prone to spending long hours in prayer, fasting, and meditation. He was always somewhat of a mystic.

In 1739, at the age of 21 he entered Yale College, considerably older than most students who, at that time, entered between ages 13 and 17. It was during this time that he came under the influence of the preaching of George Whitefield. This was known as "the time of the Great Awakening," when great revivals swept the communities all throughout the colonies. Some of the students at Yale became enthusiastic adherents to what was referred to as the "New Light Movement."

In 1741, due to illness, he had to withdraw from school for a period of time, and it was then that the first signs of Tuberculosis evidenced themselves. It led to times of melancholy and depression. He was able to return to Yale and applied himself most diligently to his studies. From an academic standpoint, he was the head of his class. Because of the emotion and fervour of the revivalists, he looked upon some of his tutors who were much more staid as being spiritually dead. On one occasion, he referred to Mr. Whittelsey, a tutor at Yale, as having no more grace than a chair. For this statement he was expelled from Yale. Brainerd was devastated by this action, and even though he asked forgiveness, and such men as Jonathan Edwards interceded in his behalf, he was never reinstated, nor did he graduate from college.

Through some of his friends, he became interested in the American Indians, and it was at this juncture that the Lord laid a burden upon his heart to minister to them. He was introduced to the Society in Scotland for the Propagating of Christian Knowledge and was invited to become an agent under that mission society. He was then commissioned to minister to the Indians living near the forks of the Delaware in Pennsylvania and to those along the Susquehanna River. He began his work in April of 1743. April 20th was his 25th birthday. He set it aside not for celebration but for fasting and prayer. He reflected on God's goodness to him. He prayed that God would sanctify his spiritual afflictions and soul distress. Wandering along in the woods, he poured out his complaint to God: "My soul is concerned not so much for souls as such but rather for Christ's Kingdom that it might appear in the world, that God might be known to be God in the whole earth."



Brainerd was not the first, nor the most successful missionary to the Indians. It was John Eliot [1604-1690] who was called the Great Apostle to the Indians. Eliot laboured as a pastor in Roxbury, two miles outside of Boston. When he was 40 years of age, he saw the great need of the Algonquin Indians. He began to study their language, which was a very difficult one, and applied himself to those studies for two years. Then be began to preach in their language with real success among these degraded people. He also began to translate the Bible. He was often ridiculed by his peers, who thought he should rather teach the Indians English, but he persisted, and by 1663 he had translated the entire Bible into their tongue. He faithfully laboured among them, establishing Christian Indian communities until his death at the age of 85.

In contrast, Brainerd was first and foremost a preacher. The central theme of his preaching was the **cross of Jesus Christ**. During these years of ministry at the forks of the Delaware and along the Susquehanna, David Brainerd was frequently soaked to the skin by rain and chilled to the bone by the snow and wind. He often slept in the forest with little or no protection from the elements. A very inadequate diet left him frequently weakened. Long sessions of fasting and prayer fed his soul but weakened his body. The long weeks on horseback or on foot, living under very primitive conditions, were most difficult and debilitating. His ministry was interspersed with frequent illnesses. He was also prone to periods of deep depression as well as heights of spiritual emotion. By June of 1745, Brainerd felt very discouraged at the hardness of hearts and so little evident fruit. He then heard of some Indians living in Crossweeksung, New Jersey. They were much more responsive to the fervent preaching of Brainerd and fell under conviction of sin, which caused real anguish of heart and at times bitter weeping. In July of that year Brainerd wrote, "**My soul, my very soul, longs for the in-gathering of the heathen, and I cry to God most willingly and heartily.**"

August 8, 1745, the windows of heaven opened and revival fire fell on these seeking hearts. He had preached fervently and frequently, and the joy of seeing souls born into the Kingdom of God brought great joy to his heart. But his health

was failing, and frequently he was very ill. He did not seek to educate the Indians into the Kingdom or reform them into the Kingdom—they were born into the Kingdom, often after violent emotional struggles. He wrote in his diary, "Here am I, Lord, send me. Send me to the ends of the earth. Send me to the rough, the savage pagans of the wilderness. Send from all that is called comfort in earth or earthly comfort. Send even to death itself if it be in Thy service and to promote Thy kingdom." More than a century later, David Livingstone said, "In Christ's service I wish to live; in it I wish to die." The revival that took place in August of 1734 brought him great joy, but it also brought him an increased burden of work as he discipled the new believers and helped them establish Christian communities. He was oftentimes severely criticized and opposed by the white colonists, many of whom called themselves Christian but showed no Christian compassion, love, or concern for the Native Americans.

One of the happiest days of his life was when he was able to baptize some of these new believers and then partake of the Lord's Supper, sharing the bread and wine with those he had seen come to the Lord through his ministry.

In the spring of '47, he was so ill that Jonathan Edwards invited him to come to his home in Northampton, Massachusetts, to recuperate. Although there were periods of some slight improvement, his condition continued to deteriorate. **Completely burned out in the service of God**, David Brainerd died at Northampton on October 9, 1747, at the age of 29. Edwards' daughter Jerusha, the flower of the family, who attended the dying young man during his last year, contracted the same disease and died a few months later at the tender age of 18. Though never confirmed, it is thought that they were engaged. They are buried side by side in the graveyard at Northampton. Jonathan Edwards, who had

befriended Brainerd and in whose home he died, was greatly impressed by the life of David Brainerd, and it was he who gave the world his diary and journals.

We can easily understand how the life of David Brainerd, one that exemplified such spiritual intensity and zeal for the salvation of souls, would have a profound impact on all who read about it. We will mention only a few. The three beloved heroes of William Carey [1761-1834], who is referred to as the Father of Modern Missions, were the Apostle Paul, John Elliot, and David Brainerd. One of the rules of the mission group in India, of which he was the leader, was to read *The Life and Diary of David Brainerd* three times a year. Carey's oft-quoted statement, "**Attempt great things for God. Expect great things from**

God" sounds very much like the following entry in Brainerd's diary of almost 100 years earlier where it is recorded, "Nothing seems too hard for God to perform, nothing too great for me to hope from Him." Henry Martyn [1781-1812] was a brilliant scholar at Cambridge and intended to pursue a legal career, but after reading The Life and Diary of David Brainerd, he wrote, "I long to be like him. Let me forget the world and be swallowed up in desire to glorify God." Martyn's statement, "Let me burn out for God," could very well have been inspired by the words of Brainerd when he wrote, "Oh, with what reluctancy did I feel myself obligated to consume time in sleep. I long to be a flame of fire, continually glowing in the divine service in building Christ's Kingdom to my last and dying moment." Both of these men died at a very early age. The saintly young pastor of Aberdeen, Robert Murray McCheyne [1813-1843], was deeply moved and influenced by studying the life of David Brainerd. John Wesley and Francis Asbury, early Methodist leaders, both held him up as models of meekness, labour, and self-denial and challenged their followers to pattern their lives after that of Brainerd. Many other well-known missionaries, such as Samuel Marsden, Robert Morrison, David Livingstone, Andrew Murray, and Sheldon Jackson, all testified to the tremendous impact that David Brainerd had upon their life and ministry. Seldom in the annuls of Christendom has there been a man like David Brainerd who sought so earnestly to be filled with the Spirit of God and who gave himself unreservedly to the glory of God as did this young man. It has been said that "David Brainerd dead" more greatly influenced the missionary cause than did "David Brainerd alive." What follows are a few of David Brainerd's quotes...

> "I love to live on the brink of eternity. May I never loiter in my heavenly journey." "All my desire was the conversion of the heathen and all hope was in God" "I want to wear out my life in His service and for His glory." "Let me forget the world and be swallowed up in the desire to glorify God." "All I want is to be more holy, more like my dear Lord."

For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.

Phil 1v21

And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but God knoweth your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God. Luke 16v15 Quite a contrast in the above two verses don't you think! I wonder what it is like to *really* live for God!

Interesting note from Alan O'Reilly!

The Cambridge Concord has Spirit in 1 John 5:8, the Cambridge Cameo has spirit. Both are correct because the reference is to a man full of the Holy Ghost i.e. the Lord Jesus Christ, Luke 4:1, Who has a spirit, small s, Mark 2:8, 8:12 but in the Lord's case, spirit and Spirit would be the same. I address this in Assurance and the Witnesses of 1 John 5 http://www.timefortruth.co.uk/bible-studies/alan-oreillys-studies.php.

Others were said to be filled with the Holy Ghost, Luke 1:15, 41, 67 but only the Lord Jesus Christ is said to be *full* of the Holy Ghost as a permanent condition *prior to Calvary*, Acts 6:3, 7:55, 11:24. I believe that distinction is important in the light of John 14:16, 17.

These made me smile!

ATTORNEY: How old is your son, the one living with you? WITNESS: Thirty-eight or thirty-five, I can't remember which. ATTORNEY: How long has he lived with you? WITNESS: Forty-five years.

ATTORNEY: Can you describe the individual? WITNESS: He was about medium height and had a beard ATTORNEY: Was this a male or a female? WITNESS: Unless the Circus was in town I'm going with male.

ATTORNEY: ALL your responses MUST be oral, OK? What school did you go to? WITNESS: Oral...

ATTORNEY: Do you recall the time that you examined the body? WITNESS: The autopsy started around 8:30 PM ATTORNEY: And Mr. Denton was dead at the time? WITNESS: If not, he was by the time I finished.

ATTORNEY: Doctor, before you performed the autopsy, did you check for a pulse? WITNESS: No. ATTORNEY: Did you check for blood pressure? WITNESS: No. ATTORNEY: Did you check for breathing? WITNESS: No. ATTORNEY: So, then it is possible that the patient was alive when you began the autopsy? WITNESS: No. ATTORNEY: How can you be so sure, Doctor? WITNESS: Because his brain was sitting on my desk in a jar. ATTORNEY: I see, but could the patient have still been alive, nevertheless? WITNESS: Yes, it is possible that he could have been alive and practicing law.

Looking back!

If you could have your time again, what would you change? I often ask people this as I'm interested in their answers. Most of us would make changes to the way we have lived if we could. We all have regrets, disappointments & things we should not have done etc. But we have to commit it all to the Lord & trust in Him for the future. I'm 43 years old now & the last 20 years have flown. *What were you doing at 43?* Sometimes I look back pondering on family times & wish things would have worked out differently, but if I dwell on it, it gets me down. Now I just try to keep pushing 'onwards & upwards' as they say. I try to set myself certain 'goals' that I want to achieve in the year. I like to have things to aim at, projects to complete, especially regarding my Christian life. In some ways, I live on a kind of 'edge' if that makes sense. I'm always looking to do more, achieve more & make the most of opportunities that arise. A lot of the time I think of how I can *create opportunities*, but ONLY if it is of the Lord's leading. I don't want to do things that the Lord isn't pleased with; I've done enough of those in my lifetime so far. Looking back is okay, but dwelling there is not healthy, so beware!

I got caught talking in my art exam at school & getting told off for it, *I never understood that either*!!! As far as I can remember, the only 'A' I received at school for art, was for a picture that my dad drew for me! It is a great talent to be able to draw, 'Ruckman' is excellent at painting & drawing!





Modern Bibles PERVERT this verse! (Info. taken from Ruckman's Reference Bible)

Dan 3v25 He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like <u>the Son of God</u>. Most, if not all, modern 'bibles' get rid of the definite article in 'the Son of God' thus destroying the obvious reference to Jesus Christ in the Old Testament! The reasoning behind this is that Nebuchadnezzar was a pagan polytheist who did not believe in the one true God who could not possibly know anything about 'the Son of God' so the modern translations change the expression to 'a son of the gods' or 'a god'. But Nebuchadnezzar was not quite as ignorant as the translators on the modern revision committees. He had obviously been having conversations with Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach, & Abednego; for he was well acquainted with Jeremiah & his prophecy in Jeremiah 39v11+12, 40v2+3. The Gentiles certainly knew about 'the sons of God' from Gen 6v1-4 (see Job 38v7). Moreover Solomon (who lived 500 years BEFORE Nebuchadnezzar) wrote about the fact in Prov 30v4 that God had a special 'son'. This 'son' showed up as 'the angel of the LORD' in Gen 32v29+30 & Judges 13v16-18 (where Jacob & Monoah asked the same question Solomon asked in Prov 30v4). In the New Testament this 'angel' is identified as Jesus Christ, the Son of God (Acts 27v23, Gal 4v14, see also Josh 5v13-15 cf. Heb 2v10). Nebuchadnezzar had obviously gotten the information from Daniel & his friends, or he had seen the Angel of the Lord & figured He would look like one of 'the sons of God!'

Lessons from Daniel Chapter 3... (Read it!)

The great spiritual lessons you learn from this chapter are 1) All rulers have the same ambition 2) You must have convictions about the word of God to STAND! 3) God's people are always under attack 4) Compromise will solve NOTHING! 5) God will honour an uncompromising stand 6) Christ is the ONLY sure protection! 7) You are responsible for your own decisions!

SIGNS! Look up all these references for some 'enlightenment!'

Dan 4v2 I thought it good to shew the signs and wonders that the high God hath wrought toward me. The word 'signs' appears twice in Dan 4v2+3. God showed His 'signs' to Nebuchadnezzar because Nebuchadnezzar was dealing with Daniel, & Daniel was a JEW (1 Cor 1v22, Exod 4v28-31). That is why Paul showed SIGNS in his work among the Gentiles – 2 Cor 12v12, Mark 16v15-18, Acts 14v8-11, 19v10-12, 28v1-9, Rom 15v16-20.

PROVE them first, before you bring them in close – 1 Tim 5v22 Lay hands suddenly on no man, neither be partaker of other men's sins: keep thyself pure. 1 Thes 5v21 Prove all things; hold fast that which is good. (Read 1 Tim 3 before going any further especially v10!) 2 Tim 3v16+17 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

Eph 1v4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: Note the phrase IN HIM i.e. IN Christ! (vs 1+3+10+12+20) 'Election' here & 'predestination' (vs 5+11) & 'adoption' (v5) & the Christian's 'inheritance' (v11) are all conditioned on being IN CHRIST! This verse is the root & source of all Calvin's HOGWASH! It is linked with Rom 9v22+23 to 'prove' that you were saved BEFORE Adam showed up, even though you were damned AFTER Adam sinned!!! Calvinists read the verse as though you were actually IN Jesus Christ 'BEFORE the foundation of the world' WHICH IS NONSENSE! No one was IN CHRIST 'before' Gen 1v1 because He had NO 'body' to be IN! If any man was, then in Gen 3v6 he got IN ADAM (Rom 5v12, 1 Cor 15v21+22). This means that

he was IN CHRIST, 'then' FELL OUT INTO ADAM, & then FELL OUT of Adam BACK INTO Christ! No man is IN Christ until He TRUSTS Christ (v13) Calvinists distort & pervert many Scriptures trying to get them to line up with their *man-mad-hellish-anti-biblical* doctrine! If you're a Calvinist you are a MUPPET! If you are looking at becoming one, you are a MUPPET! If you avoid Calvinism like a rabid-dog, you are on the right lines!



John 15v2... (Taken from RRB)

Verses 1-8 are NOT a theological description of the Body of Christ. The whole thing is a FIGURE! Notice the expression IN ME in vs 2+4-7. NOT ONE of the eleven disciples PRESENT are IN CHRIST in John 15! There is NO 'Body' of Christ until AFTER the Crucifixion (Eph 2v16) & NOT ONE OF THE DISCIPLES WAS IN IT until Acts 2 (Acts 1v5 cf. 1 Cor 12v13) In the Pauline epistles, NO Christian is described as a 'branch' on a 'vine'; they are 'members' of a 'body' (1 Cor 12v27). The passage is an ILLUSTRATION dealing with a Christian BEARING FRUIT, NOT 'keeping salvation!' Verse 6 has NOTHING to do with ANYONE getting thrown into Hell as in Mat 13v40-42, for here, it is MEN who GATHER the branches to be BURNED, NOT angels! No Christian burns literally (Rom 12v20, 1 Cor 7v9, 2 Cor 11v29, James 5v3, 1 Pet 1v7), HIS WORKS BURN (1 Cor 3v14+15)

Christians who 'promise' but DON'T 'deliver!'

Ever promised to do something but didn't keep your word? Maybe you think it is only a small matter, yet as an ambassador for Jesus Christ (2 Cor 5v20) your DISHONESTY & DISOBEDIENCE reflects back on Him. You are letting Him down & showing to the world that keeping your word is NOT important! If you have promised to give something, do something, go somewhere etc. KEEP YOUR WORD! People should be able to trust you & confide in you because you are a Christian; if you are NOT keeping your word YOU CANNOT BE TRUSTED! You KNOW who YOU ARE!!! I personally know of Christians who are always promising 'this & that' & I KNOW that they will NOT keep their word because they have never kept their word! They just spew out time & time again, the same old hollow promises & sayings that they always say (YOU KNOW WHO YOU ARE!) & I just turn to the Team & say "Complete waste of time & just another load of lies! They cannot be trusted!" Some of you have stiffed other Christians, & it hasn't bothered you in the slightest! You know what; God will be dealing with YOU at the Judgement! YOU have NOT escaped! Every time you stiff someone, God has seen it & if you are the victim or injured party, do not fret or worry, God will deal with THEM! At Time for Truth! we also get our share of 'stiffers!' So-called Christians who promise to pay & DON'T, or promise to COME & HELP & DON'T! We just commit them to the Lord & allow Him to deal with them! We don't fret or worry, we know the Lord will sort out every wrong-doing! Here at TfT! we deal with 'Christian' LIARS on a regular basis, no sweat, WE KNOW how to deal with them! I wouldn't want to be in some of your shoes when you stand before the Lord Jesus Christ I can tell you that for certain! Prov 14v5 A faithful witness will not lie: but a false witness will utter lies. Are YOU a liar?

Submitting to THE BOOK – The Authorized King James 1611 Bible ONLY!


You are to adjust your beliefs to what THE BOOK says! We are to believe what THE BOOK says, that is our starting point! If what it SAYS goes contrary to our beliefs, we are to ADJUST OUR BELIEFS to what the Bible SAYS, NOT adjust the Bible to our beliefs! If the Bible says that Jesus Christ went to HELL when He died, you are to believe what the Bible says even though you DON'T like it !!! Acts 2v27 Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. Acts 2v31 He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption. Ps 16v10 For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. Christ went to Hell because He was made sin for US! 2 Cor 5v21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. Now if you DON'T believe that, & you don't WANT to believe that, you will run to any Greek or Hebrew text you can find to prove otherwise e.g. the JW's, Christadelphians & 'James Whitewash' do it all the time! If you do, DON'T peddle that tosh around here you scum-bucket, WE are Bible BELIEVERS!!! Go sell it to your grandma! I am sick & tired of illiterate Christians running to 'the' Greek (there isn't one!!!) to PROVE that they are HERETICS! (We KNEW already!) If you want to change the AV Bible, DON'T come & bother me & DON'T bother calling, emailing or visiting me! If you can't stay with the AV Bible, GO AWAY! If you DON'T like what I say, OR the way I say it, come off the mailing list! THE BOOK, & what I mean by 'THE BOOK' is the Authorized Version Bible, is 100% PERFECT i.e. WITHOUT ERROR, & it is MY, I SAID MY, Final Authority on all matters of faith & practice! If it isn't yours, we ain't going to get along fella & I suggest you look elsewhere for a 'friend!'

Running away & hiding is NOT the answer & NEVER WILL BE the answer!

Christians that run away & hide rather than face up to LIFE, & their responsibilities, *are not worth chasing!* You either MAN-UP & deal with the 'Goliaths' in your life (which is the RIGHT thing to do) or you run away & hide, pretending that it all doesn't matter too much (which is the WRONG thing to do!) We all have problems & stresses to stand & fight against, **DON'T be a quitter**, <u>FINISH THE JOB!</u> Running away & hiding is just cowardly, & you need to pray that God will give you all the strength & courage you need to deal with your problems! Hiding will NOT help you in the short OR long term! Prov 29v25 The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe. *Ask for help!!!*

Marriage, Divorce & Remarriage! What does Scripture say on the matter?

As always, I do not care what *you* think is right, I want to KNOW what the Scriptures say & teach on the subject! Long gone are the days where you can trust what the church or your 'pastor' says, *if ever you could*! The majority of churches today have departed from the word of God & teach what they 'feel' is right & will compromise in order not to offend the majority! Here at TfT! we are ONLY concerned with what the Bible says & teaches, NOT what your pastor or leader *thinks is right*, I couldn't care less for his opinion, OR YOURS come to think of it!



Now when it comes to sins of 'sex' i.e. 'adultery', 'a remarriage' etc. Christians think that these kinds of 'sins' are unforgivable & unpardonable! You will understand what I mean by this if you have been divorced & notice the 'stigma' that other Christians want to put on you! If you have been divorced & remarried, you will also notice how 'church' members & leaders feel towards you! Most Christians have the inability to see where God has made allowances regarding REMARRIAGE etc. IN HIS BOOK for other people, other than THEMSELVES! In other words, as long as you have a happy marriage & you haven't gone through divorce, then it is WRONG & unscriptural for anyone else to! This is what we Bible

BELIEVERS call hypocrisy! Listen, I don't recommend divorce & would encourage anyone to try to work things out if they can, but in the real world, it happens, even with the best of intentions not to, IT HAPPENS! If it does, are you to stay single for the rest of your life? Some Christians would have you to, but that's because they are illiterate & unscriptural & haven't a clue when it comes to what God allows & what God teaches through His word!

What is a marriage? A marriage 'ceremony' is NOT a marriage, because a marriage 'ceremony' does NOT JOIN YOUR FLESH TOGETHER!

Let us start by looking at 1 Cor 7... READ IT before going any further, & read it ONLY in the Authorized Version Bible!

In v1+2 it is good for a man to stay single... Now concerning the things whereof ye wrote unto me: <u>It is good for a man</u> <u>not to touch a woman</u>. Nevertheless, to avoid fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband. In v7 Paul says that as far as he was concerned, it would be good for a man to stay single – For I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his proper gift of God, one after this manner, and another after that.

There is a 'condition' in v9, if you CAN'T stay single, GET MARRIED - **But if they cannot contain, let them marry: for it is better to marry than to burn**.

Note also in v7 that certain men have a 'gift' for staying single - For I would that all men were even as I myself. <u>But every</u> <u>man hath his proper gift of God</u>, one after this manner, and another after that. This goes hand in hand with what Jesus said in Mat 19v11+12 But he said unto them, All men cannot receive this saying, save they to whom it is given. For there are some eunuchs, which were so born from their mother's womb: and there are some eunuchs, which were made eunuchs of men: and there be eunuchs, which have made themselves eunuchs for the kingdom of heaven's sake. He that is able to receive it, let him receive it.

So the first admonition is for a person to stay SINGLE if possible! (*That'll please some people I know!*) Paul not only gives this advice to young men who haven't been married, but he also says in 1 Cor 7v8 I say therefore to the unmarried and widows, It is good for them if they abide even as I & again to the widow in v40 But she is happier if she so abide, after my judgment: and I think also that I have the Spirit of God. That is, she is happier staying SINGLE! So if you 'can' stay single do so, but if you 'can't' get married! (There are *advantages* & *disadvantages* for both!)

Now, what is not so clear about it, is that the Bible DEFINES marriage as a PHYSICAL MATTER in 1 Cor 7v9 **But if they** cannot contain, let them marry: for <u>it is better to marry than to burn</u>. The marriage has to do with man & woman coming together lest they BURN in lust! Look at the context of 1 Cor 7v5 Defraud ye not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and <u>come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency</u>. Marriage is FLESH JOINING FLESH! Mat 19v5 And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and <u>they twain shall be one flesh</u>? Moses said that a marriage is where FLESH JOINIS FLESH - Gen 2v23+24 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh. Then Paul makes a very interesting remark in 1 Cor 6v16 What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh. According to SCRIPTURE, a 'marriage' is where FLESH JOINS FLESH to make ONE body!

This explains why FORNICATION is warned against in 1 Cor 6v18 Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body & this thoroughly explains what Jesus Christ said in Mat 19v9 And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, <u>except it be for fornication</u>, and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery.

Now this may not be to some of your liking, but this is BIBLE! We have too many 'Christian-Pharisees' going around lording it over the flock & telling them what they can & can't do according to THEM! It is very interesting that Jesus is speaking about these matters to PHARISEES! See also in Luke 16, in talking about the law & the prophets & John, Christ suddenly says in Luke 16v18 Whosoever putteth away his wife, and marrieth another, committeth adultery: and whosoever marrieth her that is put away from her husband committeth adultery. The context was this, Luke 16v15 And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but God knoweth your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God. Don't you find that significant about 'God knowing the hearts' in view of the fact that the same Saviour who spoke to the same crowd about the same matter said in another place Mat 5v28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

What's the CONTEXT of that one? It's the righteousness of the Pharisees Mat 5v20 For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed the <u>righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees</u>, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

So the Bible BELIEVER sees the facts thus far as...

- 1) A marriage is NOT just a marriage 'ceremony!'
- 2) A marriage ceremony is NOT necessarily 'marriage!'
- 3) Marriage in the Bible is a PHYSICAL affair where FLESH JOINS FLESH!

4) Fornication with a whore constitutes that much of a marriage, i.e. FLESH JOINING FLESH!

Therefore, if a man lived a life of fornication & only had ONE marriage 'ceremony', he could pass off as only 'having one wife', whereas he had dozens; & that's what the Pharisees were doing. The Lord knew it; that is what He said, & it was said TO the Pharisees!

This bunch got upset with Paul when he wrote that FORNICATION was FLESH JOINING FLESH! (Read the following verses regarding fornication - Rom 1v29, 1 Cor 5v1, 1 Cor 6v13, 1 Cor 6v18, 1 Cor 7v2, 1 Cor 10v8, 2 Cor 12v21, Gal 5v19, Eph 5v3, Col 3v5, 1 Thes 4v3)

In John 8 when they brought that woman to Jesus Christ stating that she had been caught in the act of adultery, they quoted John 8v5 Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest thou? Now the idea behind this was, if He said 'DON'T stone her!' He'd make a liar out of Moses, & they (the Pharisees!) would get Him on that!!! If He said 'DO stone her!' Then the people would think 'Well, what about that! There He is, a friend of sinners, forgiving & having mercy on them, yet having THIS SINNER killed!' But the Lord's wisdom is PERFECT & so He stooped down & wrote on the ground, & suddenly they all left! Do you know what He wrote on the ground? It would probably have been Lev 20v10 And the man that committeth adultery with another man's wife, even he that committeth adultery with his neighbour's wife, the adulterer and the adulteress shall surely be put to death. Get it? The woman was caught in the ACT, yet WHERE WAS THE MAN? It was probably one of THEM! Moses wrote stone the WOMAN & THE MAN, not just the woman! John 8v9 And they which heard it, being convicted by their own conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, even unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.

So in the Scriptures, 'marriage' is a physical affair! The FIRST marriage has NO preacher, NO ring, NO ceremony, & NO licence! Yet today, we are to OBEY the laws of the land (Rom 13v1-5) except when they go AGAINST Scripture!

When speaking of marriage, Christ likens it to eunuchs who cannot have children physically, & Paul likens it to joining your body to a harlot! Physical!

With this in mind let us turn to Mat 19v4-6 And he answered and said unto them, Have ye not read, that he which made them at the beginning made them male and female, And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain (that's TWO!) shall be one flesh? Wherefore they are no more twain (that's TWO!), but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder. Now because this passage is read at marriage 'ceremonies,' some people think that when two people are standing at an altar, God is joining them together! Yet the context here in these verses is Adam & Eve! Think about this for a moment; are you telling me that when two UNSAVED people get married at an altar that God is joining them together? What about when a SAVED woman marries an UNSAVED man? Is God joining THEM together? The Lord tells us NOT to join an unsaved man to a saved woman, so why would He 'join' them & see it as a marriage? Look at Mat 19v7+8 They say unto him, Why did Moses then command to give a writing of divorcement, and to put her away? He saith unto them, Moses because of the hardness of your hearts suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so. WHY did Moses command to give a writing of divorcement? WHERE is that found? It is spoken of in Romans 7. It is found in the OT law, yet look at Rom 7v1-3 Know ye not, brethren, (for I speak to them that know the law,) how that the law hath dominion over a man as long as he liveth? For the woman which hath an husband is bound by the law to her husband so long as he liveth; but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of her husband. So then if, while her husband liveth, she be married to another man, she shall be called an adulteress: but if her husband be dead, she is free from that law; so that she is no adulteress, though she be married to another man. When you throw out the cross references to Mat 19v7+8 on the grounds that all that was 'Old Testament' (therefore the law was past), & you could no longer have a writing of divorcement for anything, you were told that the very place where Christ was referring to applies to a man & a woman in a Gentile church in the Body of Christ (Rom 7v1-3)

Deut 24v1 When a man hath taken a wife, and married her, and it come to pass that she find no favour in his eyes, because he hath found <u>some uncleanness</u> in her: then let him write her a bill of divorcement, and give it in her hand, and send her out of his house. Now THIS is what the Pharisees were referring to in Mat 19 (which Christ discusses in Mat 19, & to which Paul referred to in Rom 7) This is why this passage is NEVER looked up nor referred to by 'modern day Bible rejecting christians!'

Let's look at Deut 24v1 briefly... Deut 24v1 When a man hath <u>taken</u> a wife, and <u>married</u> her, and it come to pass that she find no favour in his eyes, (because WHY?) because he hath found <u>some uncleanness</u> in her: then let him write her a bill of divorcement, and give it in her hand, and send her out of his house. There was NO mention of her being a 'virgin' or having 'stepped-out' with another man! It said SOME UNCLEANNESS! That means 'anything' he didn't like! How do you know? Because the New Testament passage said that's what it was... Mat 19v8 He saith unto them, Moses because of the hardness of your hearts suffered you to <u>put away your wives</u>... Mat 19v3 The Pharisees also came unto him, tempting him, and saying unto him, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife <u>for every cause?</u> Now look at that! The bill of divorcement (spoken of in Mat 19v7 They say unto him, Why did Moses then command to give a <u>writing of divorcement</u>, and to put her away?) is the bill of divorcement in Deut 24v1 (When a man hath taken a wife, and married her, and it come to pass that she find no favour in his eyes, because he hath found <u>some</u> uncleanness in her: then let him write her a <u>bill of divorcement</u>, and give it in her hand, and send her out of his house.) The 'every cause' of Mat

19v3 is the 'some uncleanness' of Deut 24v1. Now all that is doing is comparing Scripture with Scripture! Now many modern day apostate 'christians' today teach that the only cause for a 'bill of divorcement' in the time of Moses was the fact that if a man was 'engaged' to a woman & found out that she wasn't a 'virgin', he could get rid of her! That is a load of HOGWASH & NOT what the above verses say, or mean!

In the very context you just read in Deut 24, you'll find that in v3, a man can give his wife a bill of divorcement *because he doesn't like her*! Deut 24v3 And if the latter husband <u>hate her</u>, and write her a bill of divorcement, and giveth it in her hand, and sendeth her out of his house; Those Pharisees knew that when they asked the question of Jesus Christ & said, 'Mat 19v3 ...Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for <u>every</u> cause?' In Deut 24v1-4, it is plainly NOT fornication or adultery, because one bill of divorcement is given because the man *hates his wife* (v3). So when Christ says 'Mat 19v9 And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, <u>except it be for fornication</u>, and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery.' He is setting up a NEW precedent that is NOT in Deut 24v1-4, & all understand Him! You say, 'How do you know they understand Him that way?' Look at Mat 19v10 His disciples say unto him, If the case of the man be so with his wife, it is not good to marry. Having said that the ONLY reason a man can get rid of his wife is because of FORNICATION, His disciples say unto him, If the case of the man be so with his wife, it is not good to marry. Notice they understood perfectly & exactly what Jesus Christ is talking about! They ask 'Mat 19v3 ...Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for <u>every cause</u>?'

Now the reason why we have had to cover all this BACKGROUND is because modern day apostate 'christians' all run to Rom 7 to prove otherwise, & you CANNOT understand Rom 7 until you understand THE LAW, because Rom 7v1 said that it was written to them THAT KNEW THE LAW! Rom 7v1 Know ye not, brethren, (for I speak to them that know the law,) how that the law hath dominion over a man as long as he liveth? So you had better know the Law, & what the Scriptures ACTUALLY teach, before you start going around JUDGING other Christians in regard to marriage, divorce & remarriage! Now in Mat 19, these FACTS are clear...

- Marriage is a FLESH-plus-FLESH, physical affair, which is found in vs 5+6+12... Mat 19v5 And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh? Mat 19v6 <u>Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh</u>. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder. Mat 19v12 For there are some eunuchs, which were so born from their mother's womb: and there are some eunuchs, which were made eunuchs of men: and there be eunuchs, which have made themselves eunuchs for the kingdom of heaven's sake. He that is able to receive it, let him receive it.
- 2) In the Old Testament, a man could put away his wife for ANY CAUSE! Mat 19v3 The Pharisees also came unto him, tempting him, and saying unto him, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for every cause? Deut 24v1 When a man hath taken a wife, and married her, and it come to pass that she find no favour in his eyes, because he hath found some uncleanness in her: then let him write her a bill of divorcement, and give it in her hand, and send her out of his house. Deut 24v3 And if the latter husband hate her, and write her a bill of divorcement, and giveth it in her hand, and sendeth her out of his house...

That's clear!

New Testament grounds for divorce (where you can give your wife a bill of divorcement & put her away) is FORNICATION! Mat 19v9 And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, <u>except it be for fornication</u>, and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery. Why did he say 'FORNICATION?' 1 Cor 6v16+18 What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh. Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body. If a man's wife steps out on him & joins her body to the body of another man, FLESH has left FLESH, & that man can give her a bill of divorcement & 'put her away' according to Jesus Christ!

Back to Mat 19v9 - And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, <u>except it be for fornication</u>, <u>and shall marry</u> <u>another</u>, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery. <u>NOTICE the</u> <u>REMARRIAGE in the same context with the LEGITIMATE divorce</u>! The only remarriage that is considered illegitimate is where the *grounds of divorce* are illegitimate. Where the bill of divorcement was for the right thing – FORNICATION – the remarriage was allowed! Get that! It is IN THE CONTEXT! It is in the middle of the verse!!!

Every time grounds for a LEGITIMATE divorce are mentioned, a REMARRIAGE is mentioned IN THE CONTEXT!

Example, in the case of widowhood – 1 Cor 7v39 **The wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but if her husband be dead,** <u>she is at liberty to be married to whom she will; only in the Lord</u>. That's a REMARRIAGE! This is in the case of DEATH!

Example – 1 Cor 7v27 - Art thou bound unto a wife? seek not to be loosed. Art thou loosed from a wife? seek not a wife. Note 'Art thou loosed from a wife' – notice he didn't say WHAT GROUNDS, just 'loosed!' This is a man who has been DIVORCED! 1 Cor 7v28 But and <u>if thou marry</u>, thou hast not sinned; and if a virgin marry, she hath not sinned. **Nevertheless such shall have trouble in the flesh: but I spare you**. NOTICE a REMARRIAGE here IN CONTEXT! Now on the basis of comparing Scripture with Scripture, let us look at Rom 7...

It is sound doctrine that the marriage bed is undefiled & honourable in all - Heb 13v4 Marriage is honourable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge. Sound doctrine is also found in teaching that if an

UNSAVED person wants to STAY WITH a saved person, then let them STAY & STICK TOGETHER! 1 Cor 7v12+13 But to the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother hath a wife that believeth not, and she be pleased to dwell with him, let him not put her away. And the woman which hath an husband that believeth not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him. That is Scriptural teaching & SOUND DOCTRINE!

Remember, marriage is FLESH JOINING FLESH & divorce is FLESH LEAVING FLESH, & where FLESH LEAVES FLESH, those are spiritual grounds for DIVORCE according to Jesus Christ!

Rom 7v1 Know ye not, brethren, (for I speak to them that know the law,) how that the law hath dominion over a man as long as he liveth?

Rom 7v2 For the woman which hath an husband is bound by the law to her husband so long as he liveth; but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of her husband.

Rom 7v3 So then if, while her husband liveth, she be married to another man, she shall be called an adulteress: but if her husband be dead, she is free from that law; so that she is no adulteress, though she be married to another man.

Note there is NO 'divorce' in Rom 7v1-3! Remember a 'marriage' is NOT a ceremony!

The heretical teaching taught today on this passage is as follows... 'If you were ever married, you could NEVER marry again as long as the person you were married to was still living!' They take this for granted by saying 'If she be married to another man, she had to get a *divorce* from her first husband!'

Note again, there is NO DIVORCE in Rom 7v1-3! You see that word 'loosed' in v2? That's a divorce, but that is if the man IS DEAD! You never read in v3, 'So while her FORMER husband lives, she got a DIVORCE & got married again, she is an adulteress!' YOU READ... 'While the man she is married to is ALIVE & they're still MARRIED, then if she gets another fellow, she is an adulteress!' THAT is what you READ!

Let's get the correct reading... For the woman which <u>hath an husband</u> (present tense, married to him now) is bound by the law to <u>her husband</u> (the man that's true to her, to whom she is married) so long as he liveth; but if <u>the husband</u> (the man she is married to legally & righteously) be dead, she is *loosed* (divorced) from the law of her husband (she can get married). So then if, while her husband (not the fellow 'she was divorced from', it is her husband – the man she is married to legally & righteously) liveth, she be married to another man, she shall be called an adulteress - She is guilty of what??? Adultery, & that is why she is called an 'adulteress,' because SHE IS!

Now, do you see that thing right there? Go back & look at Lev 20v10; I mean, he wrote to them that know the Law! Lev 20v10 **And the man that committeth adultery with another man's wife**, (NOT a divorced woman legally divorced & 'put away' – it is ANOTHER MAN'S WIFE!) **even he that committeth adultery with his neighbour's wife, the adulterer and the adulteress shall surely be put to death**.

So in Romans 7 the woman is NOT divorced! The man is NOT divorced! The man is true to his wife, he has NOT stepped out on her, SHE HAS STEPPED OUT ON HIM, & in doing that, she has committed two things...

1) The ACT of FORNICATION – which gives her husband a legal right to give her a bill of divorcement

2) She's committed adultery, in stepping out on him – she's an adulteress!

For the time being (until her husband gives the bill of divorcement & puts her away), in the eyes of God, she has *two men* at the same time!

Christ says to the woman in John 4v18 For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband – now this shows you the difference between speaking about it *practically* & speaking about it *legally*! You see, practically (openly), the woman has *two husbands*. She's shacking up with BOTH of them! In the eyes of the Law she would be guilty of bigamy; if she had papers to go with ONE of them, she is an adulteress – stepping out on her husband. In the eyes of God, she has swapped husbands, & her husband is single – he is LOOSED! If he is LOOSED, there is a REMARRIAGE that we looked at in 1 Cor 7v27+28.

Let's look at 1 Cor 7... In 1 Cor 7 we have another grounds for divorce, DEATH! Death 'looses' the other party & makes him (or her) single & available for REMARRIAGE. 1 Cor 7v39 The wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but <u>if</u> <u>her husband be dead, she is at liberty to be married to whom she will</u>; only in the Lord. Then we also find DESERTION, which 'looses' one party & makes them single & available for REMARRIAGE! 1 Cor 7v15 But if the unbelieving depart, let him depart. A brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases: but God hath called us to peace. So you can now see that death is NOT ONLY the grounds for divorce ACCORDING TO SCRIPTURE! Romans 7 talks about a woman STEPPING OUT on her husband, i.e. grounds for DIVORCE, i.e. it's not just 'death' that gives grounds for divorce like is commonly taught among modern day illiterate Christians!

Look at 1 Tim 3v1+2 This is a true saying, If a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work. A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach; Now that CAN'T mean 'ONLY MARRIED ONCE!' That would disqualify 1000's of ministers straight away, as many have been married more than once, especially if their first wife had died. It has to mean he is FAITHFUL TO THE ONE WIFE HE'S GOT! If he's SCRIPTURALLY & LEGALLY divorced & REMARRIED, he HAS ONLY ONE WIFE! Remember MARRIAGE is NOT a ceremony, it is FLESH JOINING FLESH!

1 Cor 7v8-10 I say therefore to the unmarried and widows, It is good for them if they abide even as I. But if they cannot contain, let them marry: for it is better to marry than to burn. And unto the married I command, yet not I, but the Lord,

Let not the wife depart from her husband: That is a commandment! The wife is told NOT to depart from her husband! But now look at v11 <u>But</u> (this is the PERMISSIVE will of God i.e. His second choice!) <u>and if she depart</u>, let her remain unmarried (not join her body up to the body of another man), or (if she IS going to join her body up to a man) be reconciled to her husband: (her body come back & join his body) and let not the husband put away his wife.

But what happens if they leave FOR GOOD? Look at 1 Cor 7v15 **But if the unbelieving depart, let him depart. A brother** (a saved man) **or a sister** (a saved woman) **is <u>not under bondage in such cases</u>: but God hath called us to peace**. Where the other party departs & DESERTS the believing party, the believing party is NOT BOUND to the party that LEAVES!

Now the modern day SLOP that most modern day preachers preach, just CAN'T handle the subject of marriage, divorce & remarriage from a SCRIPTURAL standpoint! They can only give opinion, or quote what their tradition says, i.e. Brethren, Pentecostal, Baptist etc. Many Christian 'ministers' have put 'heavy burdens & grievous to be borne' (Mat 23v4) upon a young man who's marriage has failed, & told him "That's it, no more marrying now!" This is the type of HOGWASH that is preached today in modern day 'fundamental' churches! It's CLAPTRAP!

PAUL says in 1 Cor 7v27 **Art thou bound unto a wife?** (Okay, answer...) **seek not to be loosed.** That's clear! But along comes a modern day preacher (*The kind you find in most of the churches in Worcester or Catshill, Bromsgrove*) & he tells you "Well, you've got two LIVING husbands, so you ought to divorce your second & go back to your first!" Yet we started off by saying 'I **speak to them that KNOW the LAW'** – Don't you know that the Law FORBADE that! Look at Deut 24v2-4 And when she is departed out of his house, she may go and be another man's wife. And if the latter husband hate her, and write her a bill of divorcement, and giveth it in her hand, and sendeth her out of his house; or if the latter husband die, which took her to be his wife; Her former husband, which sent her away, <u>may not take her again to be his wife</u>, after that she is defiled; <u>for that is abomination before the LORD</u>: and thou shalt not cause the land to sin, which the LORD thy God giveth thee for an inheritance. How about that! Go back to your FIRST husband, FIRST wife should you? Not according to THE LAW!

There are THREE grounds for divorce; that is, there are THREE things that LOOSE a body from another body & cause that person to be SINGLE...

- 1) FORNICATION with a REMARRIAGE in the context!
- 2) DESERTION with a REMARRIAGE in the context!
- 3) DEATH with a REMARRIAGE in the context!

We're told in 1 Cor 7v27 that if we're LOOSED from a wife, we're NOT to 'seek a wife,' BUT, if we REMARRY, WE HAVE NOT SINNED! (1 Cor 7v28)

Some modern day apostate Christians try to teach this HERESY in regard to 1 Cor 7v28 – They try to tell you that the marrying in v28 is getting married for the 'first' time, & the 'first' half of the verse refers to a MALE getting married, while the 'second' half of the verse refers to a FEMALE getting married, & this is 'proved' by the fact that it says that if a 'virgin' marry, SHE hath not sinned! (That's called STRAINING AT A GNAT & SWALLOWING A CAMEL!!! Mat 23v24) Tell me something; if the 'first' half of the verse is NOT a reference to v27 (a REMARRIAGE with a statement on a first marriage), to a person who has never been married, WHY would Paul say if a MAN MARRIES, he hasn't sinned? What would be the point of saying that, if it was a FIRST MARRIAGE? Is there anybody on planet earth who would think that the first marriage was a SIN? Christ recommended it, & Paul said it was 'honourable in all' & Paul just told them it was all right in 1 Cor 7v2+9. Now this just shows you the lengths that some modern day apostate 'ministers' will go to, to try to get around BIBLICAL TRUTH!

If what you read here is TRUE (if a man is LOOSED from a wife for any of the reasons given before), if that man is LOOSED & SINGLE, then that man has a right to REMARRY if v28 GOES WITH v27. 1 Cor 7v27+28 **Art thou bound unto a wife? seek not to be loosed. Art thou loosed from a wife? seek not a wife. But and if thou marry, thou hast not sinned; and if a virgin marry, she hath not sinned. Nevertheless such shall have trouble in the flesh: but I spare you. Notice, 'seek not a wife. <u>BUT</u>' – <u>BUT & IF THOU MARRY!</u> Why that's a reference to a man who has been LOOSED FROM A WIFE! The man who NEEDED to be told that it was ALL RIGHT to marry (because a lot of people would be convinced it would be a sin to get married if he did get married) would obviously be the man who had been LOOSED FROM A WIFE in v27!**

Summing up – There are three grounds for divorce – DEATH, DESERTION & FORNICATION! In all three cases, the party who is left alone is SINGLE, & as a SINGLE PERSON, they are allowed to REMARRY according to Scripture! (maybe NOT according to modern day apostate fundamentalists, but ACCORDING TO SCRIPTURE!)

The REMARRIAGE is warned against because of *trouble in the flesh*. The REMARRIAGE is advised against, & they are told they would be happier if they would stay single. They are told that if they get married, they will NOT HAVE SINNED, but they will have 'trouble in the flesh!'

They are given the added caution that they CAN MARRY ONLY A PERSON IN THE LORD i.e. a 'Christian!'

Now the reason I have included this study in this newsletter, is because a few of you on the mailing list recently have asked my thoughts on the issue, & quite a few of the Ruckman booklets on 'Marriage, Divorce & Remarriage' have also gone out recently. I hope the above makes sense. If you disagree with it, YOU ARE WRONG! This is the Scriptural teaching on the subject without bending ANY text to try to fit your man-made opinions or your church's standpoint on the subject. It is Biblical TRUTH, clear as crystal, & if your pastor teaches otherwise, HE IS DEAD WRONG! Amen & Amen!

Alan O'Reilly writes in regard to the TBS & the 'Pure' Cambridge Edition (PCE) AV...

Hi John, Sadly, the TBS themselves are apostate, as you can see from their comments about the originals vs. translations. They themselves cannot come up **with** a perfect and inspired Hebrew-Greek Bible even though they want you to think that one exists. This does seem like a subtle i.e. satanic attack on the AV1611 as "all scripture" that "is given by inspiration of God" 2 Timothy 3:16 by means of, on the surface, refuting actual extremists who heretically insist that only one edition of the AV1611 is the perfect Holy Bible. The refutation in that respect is actually correct but the 'heretics' are actually correct in declaring that the AV1611 is superior to the Hebrew and Greek. It's just that they do so for the wrong reason i.e. maintaining that the PCE is the only valid edition of the AV1611. This is not so, as the info. in my earlier note has shown, **sent 27/04/14 with attached PDFs KJB Settings by GAR and KJB-Differences-Cambridge-Oxford-Text by Dr Scott Johnson**. I understand that a group in the USA took the same heretical line some years back but they insisted that only the 1611 AV1611 was the pure AV1611 – not sure which of the 1611 editions they meant – i.e. the PCE lobby is just more of the same, to get you to doubt the Book you have, Genesis 3:1 and in turn support the PCE gang. Since they are based in Australia, the term bushrangers comes to mind. The TBS are much the same, as Peter's* note summarised, differing only in that their professed final authority (not their real one, as Peter showed) is their preferred Hebrew/Greek sources. Of course it never occurs to the TBS the extent to which their professed final authority, as Peter has said elsewhere, conflicts with the priesthood of all believers, 1 Peter 2:5, 9, though that "holier than thou" Isaiah 65:5 attitude too is a spin-off from Calvinism i.e. "No doubt but ye are the people, and wisdom shall die with you"

Job 12:2. *Peter Heisey, KJB missionary to Romania

The TBS article focuses on the terms Spirit versus spirit, insisting that for various verses, the reference is to the Spirit of God, so Spirit should have a capital S. The situation is as follows for the 1611 AV1611, Cambridge Cameo Edition, Cambridge Concord Edition, PCE respectively for the verses that the TBS article mentions.

Numbers 11:29 - Spirit, spirit, spirit, Spirit

Isaiah 59:21 - spirit, spirit, spirit, spirit

Ezekiel 11:24, 43:5 - spirit, Spirit, Spirit, Spirit / Spirit, spirit, spirit, spirit

Matthew 4:1 - Spirit, Spirit, Spirit, Spirit

Mark 1:12 - Spirit, Spirit, Spirit, Spirit

1 Corinthians 2:12 re of God - Spirit, spirit, spirit, spirit

The TBS of course uses the above examples to exalt the Hebrew/Greek over the AV1611 English but that is a false distinction. Dr Ruckman has pointed out that spirit small s in the expression spirit of God can refer to the office or ministry of the Holy Ghost as distinct from His Person as the third Member of the Godhead, 1 John 5:7. See Dr Ruckman's commentary The Books of First and Second Corinthians p 46. Either reading could therefore apply in the above verses, though with the revelation of the Holy Ghost as such in the New Testament, John 14-16, the term Spirit is used more often no doubt to put the emphasis on His Person. 1 Corinthians 2:12 is an exception but I suggest that a contrast is being drawn between the diametrically opposed ministries/offices of the two spirits mentioned. In any event, the differences – or issues – between AV1611 Editions don't amount to zip, as earlier notes and attachments have shown. The issue as a whole is just another papal-SJ smokescreen, as also indicated earlier. The article bangs on about the supposed superiority of the Hebrew/Greek over the King's AV1611 English on p 18 (666, Revelation 13:18!) but here again the TBS is wrong. By exalting the Hebrew/Greek, they fail to see that they have:

1. Violated the priesthood of all believers, 1 Peter 2:5, 9, as indicated above

2. Confined "the scripture of truth" Daniel 10:21 to words NOT easy to be understood in the Old Testament by most folk i.e. Hebrew in violation of 1 Corinthians 14:9 and to a DEAD language in the New Testament i.e. 1st century Greek, in violation of 1 Peter 1:23

3. Failed to appreciate the Biblical associations of the precise expressions "in the Greek" and "in the Hebrew" Revelation 9:11, the only time these expressions occur together in the scripture in the same verse and the only time the expression "in the Greek" occurs in scripture.

4. Condemned "the scripture of truth" Daniel 10:21 to degeneration by loss of information in transmission i.e. translation. As I've said before, they therefore make a liar out of the Lord Jesus Christ in Matthew 24:35, Mark 13:31, Luke 21:33 and declare that salvation is itself degenerative i.e. no-one has salvation, contradicting James 1:21, 1 Peter 1:23 and making liars out of these apostles as well.

Matthew 5:18 does not make the Hebrew/Greek pre-eminent. Aside from the fact that English as such did not exist on earth then, itself invalidating the TBS claim to Hebrew/Greek pre-eminence, what Matthew 5:18 does is to preclude any notion of an authoritative BC Greek LXX. The Lord did not recognise such. We know that the LXX didn't exist until after the apostolic age but the myth of the BC LXX persists. The Lord did away with it, along with the apocryphal books, noting Matthew 5:17 and Luke 24:44. Matthew 5:18, Luke 24:44 are the Biblical proofs of that, independent of historical proof, considerable though that is, see Dr Ruckman's Christian's Handbook of Manuscript Evidence Chapters 2-5. In any event, the Hebrew/Greek so-called are no longer authoritative as Gail Riplinger has show exhaustively in Hazardous Materials, Greek & Hebrew Study Dangers.

Matthew 5:18 is in fact a support to Matthew 24:35, Mark 13:31, Luke 21:33 and a testimony to no loss of information in transmission i.e. translation, not the opposite.

The TBS analogy with a flowing stream is wrong and John 13:16 has been wrested out of context, 2 Peter 3:16. The TBS forgot that the Lord can make a river rise above its source, Joshua 3:16 and, as Dr Gipp has pointed out, that in scripture, translations

are not the servants of but superior to **the** originals, 2 Samuel 3:9, 10, Colossians 1:13, Hebrews 11:5. **See** <u>samgipp.com/answerbook/</u> Question 30 Can a Translation be as Good as the Originals?

The TBS also don't appreciate that they are servants of God themselves and therefore don't have a choice about departing from the AV1611 by any means, 1 Corinthians 6:19, 20. They are supposed to go with the Lord's choice not their own, Psalm 138:2 i.e. if the Lord has magnified His word above all His name, it is magnified above ourselves. However, only AV1611 believers can produce a copy of that word extant as a single Book between two covers. The TBS can't and neither can any of the AV1611's other critics.* See Dr Ruckman's Reference Bible p 1444 and comments on Acts 8:27, also www.timefortruth.co.uk/why-av-only/ Royal Law – James 2:8. We have a lot of Biblical Guy Fawkeses in this country.

*The TBS wrote to me back in 1985 and said that they didn't like "whale" in Matthew 12:40, "Easter" in Acts 12:4 and "and shalt be" in Revelation 16:5. See Will Kinney's article <u>brandplucked.webs.com/rev165shaltbe5810us.htm</u> on Revelation 16:5 and note this extract "Jack Moorman, in his "When the King James Departs from the "Majority Text", says: "The King James reading is in harmony with the four other places in Revelation where this phrase is found.

1:4 "him which is, and which was, and which is to come"

1:8 "the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty"

4:8 "Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come"

11:17 "Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come"

Indeed Christ is the Holy One, but in the Scriptures of the Apostle John the title is found only once (1 John 2:20), and there, a totally different Greek word is used. The Preface to the Authorized Version reads, "With the former translations diligently compared and revised". (Jack Moorman)." Will Kinney mentions a Latin commentary on Revelation with the reading "and shalt be" as in the AV1611 in Revelation 16:5 dating from 380 A.D. The King James translators may well have had such old Latin sources among the former translations that they used that supported Beza's 1598, 1598 Greek NT editions that have "and shalt be" in Revelation 16:5 that in turn rightly influenced the translators' work. The TBS notwithstanding, God has certainly honoured the AV1611 reading "and shalt be" Revelation 16:5 for the last 400+ years. The TBS can produce no Book that is inspired scripture that inserts all the changes that the TBS would seem to want to see in the AV1611.

The TBS **article's** appeal to historical testimony is fallacious. Historical testimony shows that Bible believers of the past believed the AV1611 to be perfect by comparison with the original Hebrew/Greek and even superior to it.

John Charles Ryle was the first Church of England Bishop of Liverpool. In the 1870s, he wrote a book entitled *The Christian Leaders of the Last* (i.e. 18th) *Century*, about the great revival preachers like Whitefield and Wesley. He said this about these preachers and the 1611 Holy Bible, his emphases.

"The spiritual reformers of the last century taught constantly **the sufficiency and supremacy of Holy Scripture**. The Bible, whole and unmutilated, was their sole rule of faith and practice. They accepted all its statements without question or dispute. They knew nothing of any part of Scripture being uninspired. They never allowed that man has any "verifying faculty" within him, by which Scripture statements may be weighed, rejected or received. "In all these instances the Bible means the translation authorised by King James the First...to this day the common human Britisher or citizen of the United States of North America accepts and worships it as a single book by a single author, the book being the Book of Books and the author being God."

In the Waiting Room! (By Donna)

What are we waiting for? What are our expectations? What preparations have we made? What's the end result going to be? Will there be disappointment?

Life at times can seem so complex. Recently in a hospital waiting room my mind started to wander as I saw different people, of varying ages and 'class' coping, or not, with the situations they found themselves in. The Lord has made us all different and yet in many ways we are so alike. Concerning our bodies it is funny to think that on the whole we all have the same organs, tissues, parts etc. yet we are all unique.

At the hospital some people were sitting alone, which always seems sad, while others had family/friends with them. Some were eating; reading, chatting, and one man in particular had his headphones on and looked like he was falling asleep! It was this man that made me think of other waiting rooms we may have been in and experienced, and still may do in the future; what the feelings were like there compared to the hospital. "Spirit" or "spirit"?

"Spirit" or "spirit"? Is there a problem?

A sister writes: "OK, guys, I need your help.

1 John 5:8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, the ?pirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one. What goes where the ? is and why? The answer is not as easy as it seems. Deb

Hi Deb. No, the answer is not as easy as it seems. The word "spirit" can have several meanings or a different emphasis depending on both the context of a phrase or verse and whether or not it is capitalized.

The King James Bible uses both a capitalized Spirit and a small spirit. Some printings of the KJB have a small "s" in spirit in this verse, but most have a capital S and read Spirit.

Older Bible versions used a small "s" in this particular verse.

Wycliffe 1395 - "And thre ben, that yyuen witnessing in erthe, the spirit, water, and blood; and these thre ben oon."

Tyndale 1525 - "For there are thre which beare recorde in erth: the sprete and water and bloud: and these thre are one."

Coverdale 1535 - "And there are thre which beare recorde in earth: the sprete, water and bloude, and these thre are one." The Great Bible (Cranmer) 1540 - "And ther are thre which beare recorde the sprete & water, and bloud: & these thre are one." Matthew's Bible 1549 - "For there are thre, whiche beare recorde in earth the spyrite and water, and bloude, and these thre are

one." Bishops' Bible 1568 - "And there are three which beare recorde in earth, the spirite, and water, and blood, and these three agree in one."

The Geneva Bible 1587 - "And there are three, which beare record in the earth, the spirit, and the water and the blood: and these three agree in one."

The Douay-Rheims 1610 - "And there are three that give testimony on earth: the spirit and the water and the blood. And these three are one."

Actually, it was the King James Bible that was the first English Bible to capitalize the "s" in this verse. The original 1611 printing read:

King James Bible 1611 - "And there are three that beare witnesse in earth, the Spirit, and the Water, and the Blood, and these three agree in one."

I have hard copies of the Cambridge KJB, the World Publishing Company, Zondervan and the Oxford University Press King James Bible, The Scofield Reference Bible 1945, and all four of them have a capital S here in 1 John 5:8 and read: "And there are three that bear witness in earth, **the Spirit**, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one."

Also having a capital S for Spirit here are Darby 1890, Young's 1898, the Revised Version 1881, the ASV 1901, RSV, NRSV 1989, ESV 2001-2011, NIV, NASB, Holman Standard and the NKJV 1982. I have hard copies of them all.

A few Bibles still used a small "s" in this verse even after the KJB came out. For example:

Mace New Testament 1729 - "so that there are three witnesses, the spirit, the water, and the blood: and these three testify the same thing.

Whitson's Primitive N.T. 1745 - "The spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one."

Most modern Versions use a capitalized "S" in this verse and now read "Spirit". Among these are the RV, ASV 1901, Weymouth 1902, Williams N.T. 1937, Goodspeed 1943, J.B. Phillips N.T. 1962, the RSV, NRSV, ESV, NASB, NKJV, NIV, NET, Holman Standard, Darby, Youngs, ISV (International Standard Version), The Voice 2012, the Orthodox Jewish Bible 2011 - "the Ruach Hakodesh and the mayim and the dahm", the Lexham English Bible 2011, KJV 21st Century Version 1994, Common English Bible 2011 and the Jubilee Bible 2000-2010 to name but a few.

Keep in mind that the Greek language does not use special upper or lower case letters when referring to God the Father, God the Son or the spirit or the Spirit. And in the case of "Spirit" versus "spirit" - when referring to either the Person or the influence of the Deity - the lines can become so close as to be virtually identical.

Sometimes in Scripture the capitalized "Spirit" can refer to the Third Person of the Holy Trinity. But the word "spirit" with a small "s" often refers not so much to the Person of Deity, as it does to the "working, activity, influence, animating principle, essential quality, disposition, energy or the driving force" behind something.

The Old Testament Scriptures speak of "the spirit of wisdom" (Exodus 28:3; Deut. 34:9), the "spirit of jealousy" (Num. 5:14,30), the "spirit of my understanding" (Job 20:3), "a contrite spirit" (Ps. 34:18), "a right spirit" (Ps. 51:10), "thy holy spirit" and "thy free spirit" (Ps. 51:11,12), "a broken spirit" (Ps. 51:17, Pro. 17:22), "a faithful spirit" (Pro. 11:13), "an haughty spirit" (Pro. 16:18), "an humble spirit" (Pro. 16:19), "an excellent spirit" (Pro. 17:27) "the proud in spirit" (Ecc. 7:8), "the spirit of judgment" and "the spirit of burning" (Isaiah 4:4), the "spirit of counsel" and "the spirit of knowledge" (Isaiah 11:2), "the spirit of Egypt" (Isa. 19:3), "a perverse spirit" (Isa. 19:14), "a spirit of judgment" (Isa. 28:6), "the spirit of deep sleep" (Isa. 29:10), "the spirit of heaviness" (Isa. 61:3), "an excellent spirit" (Dan. 5:12), "spirit of whoredoms" (Hosea 4:12; 5:4), "the spirit of grace and supplications" (Zech. 12:10).

In the New Testament, the Bible refers to such things as "ye know not what MANNER OF SPIRIT ye are of" (Luke 9:55), "the wisdom and the spirit by which he spake" (Acts 6:10), "the spirit of holiness" (Romans 1:4), "newness of spirit" (Rom.7:6), "the spirit of bondage" (Romans 8:15), "the spirit of slumber" (Rom. 11:8), "the spirit of the world" (1 Cor. 2:12), "the spirit of meekness" (1 Cor. 4:21), "spirit of faith" (2 Cor. 4:13), "the spirit of wisdom and revelation" (Eph. 1:17), "the spirit of your mind" (Eph. 4:23), "the spirit of his mouth" (2 Thes. 2:8), "the spirit of fear" (2 Tim. 1:7), "a meek and quiet spirit" (1 Peter 3:4), "the

spirit of glory" (1 Peter 4:14), "spirit of antichrist" (1 John 4:3), "the spirit of truth" (1 John 4:6), "the spirit of error" (1 John 4:6) and finally "the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy." (Revelation 19:10)

So, what we sometimes see in Scripture is that God will speak of His Spirit and also of His "spirit", and "the spirit of the Lord" and "the Spirit of God" and also "the Spirit of God" and "My spirit" as well.

See examples of the small "s" in the word "spirit" in the King James Bible in Genesis 6:3; Exodus 31:3; 35:31; Numbers 24:2, Isaiah 11:2; 40:7; 42:1; 44:3 and 59:21.

These are not errors at all, but are verses that describe the "working, activity, influence, animating principle, essential quality, disposition, energy or the driving force" of God behind various actions He carries out rather than to the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity, the Holy Ghost.

As for the original question about 1 John 5:8, I believe the first printing of the King James Bible in 1611 got it right as do most Publishing companies today who print the King James Bible. "And there are three that bear witness in the earth, the Spirit, and the water and the blood; and these three agree in one."

However other Bibles that have a small "s" here and say "three that bear witness in the earth, the spirit, and the water and the blood" may be focusing more on the idea of the working or the energizing power of "the spirit of truth" (1 John 4:6) than of the direct action of the Holy Ghost.

Foreign language Bibles that also have a capital "S" in the word Spirit in 1 John 5:8 are the following: The French Martin 1744, Louis Segond 1910 and French Ostervald 1996 - "l'Esprit, l'eau, et le sang", the Italian Diodati 1649, 1991 and La Nuova Riveduta 2006 - "lo Spirito, e l'acqua, e il sangue", the Spanish Sagradas Escrituras 1569, the Cipriano de Valera of 1602 and the Reina Valeras from 1909 to 1995 - "el Espíritu, y el agua, y la sangre", Luther's German Bible 1545 and German Schlachter 2000 - "der Geist und das Wasser und das Blut", the Portuguese Almeida 1681 and the modern Portuguese Bibles - "o Espírito, e a água, e o sangue", the Dutch Staten Vertaling -"de Geest, en het water, en het bloed", the Tagalog Ang Dating Biblia 1905 and the Tagalog Ang Salita ng Diyos of 1998 - "ang Espiritu, ang tubig, at ang dugo", the Romanian Cornilescu - "Duhul, apa şi sîngele", the Hungarian Károli bible - "a Lélek, a víz és a vér" and even Scrivener's 1894 Greek text (Trinitarian Bible Society) as well as the Greek Orthodox text of 1904 have a capital letter for "Spirit" - τὸ Πνεῦμα, καὶ τὸ ὕδωρ, καὶ τὸ αἶμα·

Of much greater concern should be the fact that most of today's new Vatican Versions like the ESV, NIV, NASB completely omit some 23 words and the strongest teaching in the Bible about the Trinity from 1 John 5:7-8.
