Calvinistic Pastor from Long Crendon Baptist Church in Aylesbury contacts me about my 'tone'!?



Luke 13v5 I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish. Repentance is being sorry for what you ARE – Job 40v4, 42v6, Isa 6v5, Luke 5v8, so you are turning from your unbelief in God as a filthy sinner & turning towards God for salvation, that's it. You mature as a Christian the deeper you get into the word of God, & not only that, but you are able to cope with people, situations, & being offended much better the more you read & study the Bible – Mark 4v17. There is a peace the word of God brings that nothing else in life does, yet most Christians are unaware of that because they are not reading their Bibles. You will be able to cope with 'being offended' much better if you are a Christian that is deep in the Scriptures... so are you? Or are you a very weak & immature Christian who runs away the moment you are offended? Here are some other great verses on the subject... John 6v61 – many of Jesus' disciples were offended by what He said & no longer wanted to walk with Him (John 6v66). Read 1 Cor 8v13 alongside Rom 14v21 – do you offend others by 'drinking', yet you have decided that as a Christian you would rather drink alcohol & be part of the world & its sin than obey the Scriptures. Does your 'pastor' or 'leader' drink alcohol? Not bothered? James 3v2 – have YOU ever offended anyone & if so what was it over? We all do it don't we? Prov 18v19 A brother offended is harder to be won than a strong city: and their contentions are like the bars of a castle. Man alive, what about this verse! Once you have offended someone, especially these days, you'll find it near impossible to win them over again. Mat 16v23 – if you were Peter would you have been offended by Jesus here? Jesus Himself is an offence to many - Rom 9v33, 1 Pet 2v6-8. The Cross is also an offence to many – Gal 5v11. There are many things that offend us, but it's how you deal with them that shows your spirituality & maturity. If you run away every time you're offended, you're just a very immature Christian. We've had lot's of them come & go at The Oaks Church. Those that stay grow spiritually & mature very quickly. Offended?

NASB Jesus Lies

King James Bible John 7:8-10 "Go ye up unto this feast: I go not up vet unto this feast; for my time is not yet full come." When he had said these words unto them, he abode still in Galilee. But when his brethren were gone up, then went he also up unto the feast. not openly, but as it were in secret.


New American Standard Bible Jn. 7:8-10

"Go up to the feast yourselves; I do not go up to this feast because My time has not yet fully come." Having said these things to them, He stayed in Galilee. But when His brothers had gone up to the feast, then He Himself also went up, not publicly, but as if, in secret.

- The King James Bible accurately reports that the Lord said he was not going up to the feast YET because he did go up later.

Emailing Banksy

I love to see talented painters & artists, but I just don't appreciate art that costs millions & you can't even fathom out what it is... Hancock & 'The Rebel'!!!



Do you understand Acts 2v38 properly?

First let us read Rom 3v25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; 'Propitiation' occurs 3x in Scripture - 1 John 2v2, 1 John 4v10 & here. In each case it is Jesus Christ Himself who satisfies the demands of God (Read Rom 3v25-31). The Father twice declared that He was 'well pleased' with His Son (Mat 3v17 & 17v5), read also Isa 53v10+11. You appropriate that 'satisfaction' when you trust in His Blood Atonement for you. Without Christ you are on death row awaiting execution – John 3v18+36. Now Rom 3v25 is essential for understanding Acts 2v38. Note the wording in both... 'remission of sins'. Most Christians interpret this to mean... 'in order to get the forgiveness of sins', but this is not what it means. 'For the remission of sins' occurs in the ministry of John the Baptist (Luke 3v3 & note 'baptism of repentance FOR...'); 'For the remission of sins' occurs at the Last Supper where Jesus says – Mat 26v28 (read it). It also occurs in Acts 2v38. Back to Rom 3v25 & note... 'To declare his righteousness FOR THE REMISSION OF SINS THAT ARE PAST'. What sins are those? Those are the sins He forgave from Gen 3 to Rom 3. How do you know that? By the next phrase... 'Through the forbearance of God'. Even though not one sin in the Old Testament was ever 'taken away' (Heb 10v4), or 'cleared' (Exo 34v7), the Lord put up with those sinners & forgave their sins when they did what He asked them to do, until such a time when the one perfect, effectual sacrifice could be made & His righteousness could be applied to all those forgiven sins to REMOVE them. It has to do with a period of time (Rom 3v26), not the time of a man's life. So, 'for the remission of sins' means BECAUSE THE SINS OF THE PAST HAVE ALREADY BEEN FORGIVEN. Mat 26v28 is a direct cross-reference to Rom 3v25! In the case of John the Baptist, the people are showing by their baptism that they have already repented & had their sins forgiven. They were then to leave the waters of baptism & do works that matched their repentance. In Acts 2v38, four separate things were taking place...

- 1) They were to repent of the sin of crucifying Jesus Christ
- 2) They were to be baptised to show that they had repented
- 3) Their sins had already been forgiven when they repented just like in the case of John the Baptist
- 4) If they did that, THEN they would receive the Holy Spirit

Let's look at one more passage showing that these PAST SINS were sins forgiven under the Old Testament - Heb 9v22. The blood here is NOT Christ's Blood, it was the blood shed at the brazen altar in the tabernacle (Read Heb 9v18-22). It was the blood of calves & goats – Heb 9v19. In the Old Testament under the Law, a man could have his sins 'forgiven' if he made the proper sacrifice, but the sins were NOT 'taken away' - Heb 10v4. So when Christ dies on the Cross, His Blood does more than just 'forgive', it 'redeems' (Col 1v14) the blood shed in the OT, & clears away the sin that has already been forgiven – Heb 9v15+26 – read Heb 10v4+11, 1 Pet 1v18+19, Exod 34v7. Redemption is NOT forgiveness & forgiveness is NOT redemption – Col 1v14 (cf. NIV). What we have is the Blood atonement of Christ; it is completed redemption, NOT JUST the forgiveness of sins. The Blood of Christ accomplishes BOTH operations.

Amazing – the word 'atonement', meaning the reconciliation of God & mankind through the death of Jesus Christ, occurs 70 times, 69 times in the OT & ONLY ONCE in the NT – Rom 5v10+11.

Heb 9v28 So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.

1 Pet 3v18 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:

Heb 10v12 **But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God**; In the OT the sheep died for the shepherd, in the NT the Shepherd dies for the sheep!

What are you running away from & why? What is stopping you from facing up to your poor decisions, PRIDE? Are you really where God wants you to be at present? Are you at peace? If not... you know why!

TOP Christian Books IN THE WORLD! Don't Miss Out - Dr. Gene Kim

Pastor's Mike Schreib & Gene Kim from Bible Baptist Church International have a YouTube channel which I think is one of the best on the internet. Their preaching is very sound & very balanced unlike most other KJV preachers & teachers. Why I also highly recommend them is because they are both humble, & humility is one

thing I seldom see among those who know their Bibles, & these two brothers KNOW their Bibles! I don't recommend a lot of preachers & teachers because there are problems with many of them (arrogance for a start), & they may lead you astray. 


Encouraging each other...



Preview - HISTORICAL PRINCIPALS IN INTERPRETATION - Those who allegorize the Bible really don't care what the context of passages are — as long as they can use them to their benefit. Sincere and honest believers will ask who is speaking when reading a passage. Just because a quotation comes from the Bible doesn't mean what is said in that quotation is right or even good. For instance, in the book of Ecclesiastes, the author is a man "under the sun" (Ecclesiastes 1:3, 9, 14 etc.), and it is written from that viewpoint. So, when Solomon says, "There is nothing better for a man, than that he should eat and drink, and that he should make his soul enjoy good in his labour" (Ecclesiastes 2:24), that doesn't mean you should quit going to church so you can stay home and stuff yourself. Likewise, when he says, "All go unto one place; all are of the dust, and all turn to dust again" (Ecclesiastes 3:20), he's not giving a doctrinal statement on life after death. You must be careful when reading the Bible, because even some of Satan's words are recorded in Scripture, but you would be a fool to follow them as instructions. The context of a word or phrase in Scripture is so very important because the context lays the foundation upon which that phrase is built. Just because a word or phrase is contained in

Scripture does not validate it to be true. The words of Gamaliel sound good: "if it be of God, ye cannot overthrow it" (Acts 5:39), but are they true? The Roman Catholic Church hasn't been overthrown yet, so is it of God? What about Islam or Mormonism? When the context of that phrase in Acts 5:39 is considered, it is clear that Gamaliel was an unbelieving Pharisee and wasn't speaking authoritatively for God at all! We know that God is the author of the Bible and that the Bible is intended for man, but when we deal with the specifics of Bible passages, we must be careful. The entire Bible was written for us, but not all of the Bible was written directly to us! This concept is particularly helpful while reading passages like Acts chapter two, where a distinctly Jewish message is preached to a Jewish audience. The requirement of water baptism as a prerequisite for getting the Holy Ghost (Acts 2:38) should be a "red flag" for anyone today reading the passage. Attempting to use verse 39 as proof that verse 38 should be applied to us is double jeopardy because verse 39 is actually an Old Testament quotation from Daniel 9:7 – a reference to the Jews of the dispersion, not Gentiles. It is also important to understand that many things referred to in the Bible are purely a part of historical culture and are not commands for Christians today – some things are doctrine and other things are historical culture. For example, many Primitive Baptist churches practice foot washing, which typically "takes place after communion," because they claim it is an ordinance for the church and should be observed based on John 13:14 where Jesus washed the disciples' feet. Is foot washing an ordinance for local churches or just a part of the culture during the time of Christ? First, notice in John's Gospel that the Lord is not in a local church setting like you find today; He is "in first century Palestine, where people walked long distances in sandals and where roads were dusty." In the culture of Christ's day, the host typically washed the feet of his guests. The next thing to listen for is the sound of crickets, because the rest of the Bible is silent on this topic. You will not find foot washing in the Acts of the Apostles or commanded in any of Paul's epistles. Finally, we must admit that foot washing merely cleans feet and isn't a picture of the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ like baptism (1 Peter 3:21), and neither does it commemorate Jesus's death, burial and resurrection like the Lord's Supper does (1 Corinthians 11). Foot washing then, isn't an ordinance, nor does it commemorate anything but a cultural practice. If you visit a church that observes foot washing and they want you to "unloose," just tell them to "pucker up" because holy kisses were also part of the culture of the day (Romans 16:16; 1 Corinthians 16:20, etc.)! Formerly called "The Bible Believer's Guide to Dispensationalism".

It figures that B.I. are right as we are now a very corrupt society in Government, morals, lawlessness etc. Our country has gone to pot I don't know how much longer the Lord is going to put up with the evil deeds of this country but He is long suffering. Galatians 6:7 says Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. In Psalm 6:5 it says For in death there is no remembrance of thee: in the grave who shall give thee thanks? But what about the rich man in Luke 16? In 1 John 3:1, and in other places, in the margin of the AV sons of God is changed into children of God. None of my Bibles have it in the margin (I have quite a few of them). Dr Peter Ruckman speaks of it and in other places in his notes but he says it should read sons of God. I don't take my PR study Bible to church as it is too heavy and print too small. I think the translators were far seeing in that we are all male/sons in heaven, we are like Jesus Christ and we shall see Him as He is (33 1/2 year old male) Also we are like the angels in heaven. Angels are all male, not one is mentioned in Scripture as being female. I am glad to be called a son, they get the inheritance. (I know that some daughters in Scripture did as well) Hebrews 10:25. In the very early days the Christians gathered together wherever it was convenient, they did not have a special building, they assembled together in a house, barn or field etc., to worship Jesus Christ their Saviour and God their Father. All baptised believers, to read the Scriptures (O.T.) and learn and sing hymns, Psalms and spiritual songs. There were no unbelievers there. Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? 2 Corinthians 6:14.15 They were encouraged to gather together for encouragement and inspiration etc. Assembling of Bible believers - born again and baptised. There were no unsaved there. They came together to remember Jesus Christ and took the Lord's supper 1 Corinthians 11, as instituted by the Lord Himself. These kinds of saints continued throughout history, a remnant in spite of the Roman church, and later the Protestants. Hebrews was written for the Jews and was probably for them during the tribulation. I guess in time these fractions of Christians world wide decided they should meet in large purpose built buildings. Also the splinter churches from the Apostolic age set up denominations. Each denomination had its traditions as well as biblical doctrine, until today when you get nearly all churches unbiblical in ground/basis. The body of Christ is the church, His bride and members are all born again believers. To be born again is to turn your life around and live a Christ filled life, Jesus said Ye must be born again. In the Pauline letters we are shown how to behave, what to wear and the order of those in charge. No one man can "lord it" over the others. No one man takes over the entire meeting/service, no one has a title, i.e. pastor, vicar, priest, reverend etc., we are all brothers and sisters in Christ. Of course there must be Elders, Bishops and Deacons (plural) or like the church at Corinth, there would be chaos and unruly. All things must be done in order. So many traditions of mans liking have crept into these denominations there is little resemblance of the original "assembling ourselves together", not to mention that most of the folk who attend the majority of churches are not born again. Originally preachers went out with the gospel and brought in the converts. If Adam looked at all the animals to look for a helpmeet – and at the same time named them – but couldn't find any suitable to be his wife – none in his likeness, they were animals and he was man. So evolution is a myth on these grounds. So that is it for this time, hope my thoughts have given you something to think about too. And Revelation 22:12 says And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be. EVEN SO, COME, LORD JESUS.

Who are you helping? What good are you doing for others? When was the last time you stepped outside your comfort zone to do good for someone else? What sacrifices have you made for others? Do you care? Are you willing to change?

Preaching & teaching God's word...

No matter how small your congregation, mine is very small indeed, I always want to give my best when preaching & teaching. I want to feed the flock as directed to in Acts 20v28 with fresh 'meat' (1 Cor 3v2, Heb 5v12-14), not give them stale old meat dragged up 'again'. There are many times when I'm teaching that I feel very inadequate & only wished I knew the Book much better than I do. I convict myself that I should be spending a lot more time in the word, so I can keep giving out profitable material (Acts 20v20), I never want to 'just give a sermon', I want the words to come from my heart being guided by the Spirit of God so that we can all feast on the word of God together. I do not put more effort in if more people come, I give my best even if just one turned up. Because the word of God is so convicting I also feel a hypocrite at times, as I know I should be doing what I am preaching (Rom 2); it's easy in many ways to 'preach' & say what we *should* be doing, but to live that out, that's the tough part isn't it. I've said it before I know, but reading the Scriptures can really beat you up can't it, it convicts & rebukes you, it shows you where you are going wrong & what you should do to put things right. That is why a lot of people who backslide stop reading their Bibles immediately, some even get rid of them because they just can't stand their conscience being pricked all the time knowing it is in the house.

Great little study on Luke 15v1-7 taken from Ruckman's commentary with a few added bits.

Read Luke 15v1-7. Thank the Lord that He ate with sinners & He received sinners – I'm a sinner! (Rom 5v8). Now the spiritual application to these verses is that Jesus is the Good Shepherd who gives His life for the sheep (John 10v11). He came to seek you as a sheep who had 'gone astray' (Isa 53v6) & save you (Luke 19v10). The Holy Spirit was sent to seek you & draw you to Christ. The Father waits to receive you if you will come to Him in repentance & faith (even though Hyper-Dispensationalists don't get / understand that). Now applying these verses 'doctrinally' is something else! If you make the lost sheep a 'saved' man, like you find in John 10v26-28, how come the Good Shepherd has 'lost' one? See how easily it would be to teach that you CAN lose your salvation from this passage? You CANNOT lose your salvation in THIS dispensation Note also in John 10v28! Now if you make the sheep a 'lost' man, the Good Shepherd now 'leaves' 99 saved sheep 'in the wilderness' (v4) to go find one lost sheep. What is He doing leaving ANY of His sheep when He said 'I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee' Heb 13v5. How is it that only one sheep went 'astray' (Mat 18v12) when the Bible says 'ALL we like sheep have gone astray' Isa 53v6? See the problems here regarding doctrinal application?

So if Jesus is NOT talking about saved men & lost men 'doctrinally', then to whom is He referring to? Read Ps 100v3 Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. God's people in the OT are Israel (2 Chron 7v14). THEY are His sheep, & He calls them 'my flock' throughout Ezek 34. The parable is given in response to one group of Jews (the Pharisees & scribes – Luke 15v2), complaining about *another* group of Jews (the publicans & sinners – Luke 15v1), coming to Christ. Jesus is explaining to the Pharisees & scribes His purpose in regards 'to the lost sheep of the house of Israel' (Mat 10v6).

So like we say, you can use this passage in Luke 15 as good Gospel preaching, but doctrinally it's not aimed at Gentiles or the Church. Good preaching is not always good doctrine, & good doctrine is not always good preaching – remember that. This is why Hyper-dispensationalists (e.g. Colic-Caldwell, Fake-Pfenny etc.) are never able to lead a soul to Christ & do not care about getting the Gospel out to sinners; they would rather just keep chopping up the Bible & telling everyone what parts you shouldn't be reading; 'Hypers' are useless.

Like Ruckman says, he uses Rom 6v23 & Rev 3v20 all the time when reaching lost souls, yet neither verse was written to a LOST man DOCTRINALLY.


So going back to Luke 15... you can certainly preach it as Jesus Christ is coming to find the lost sinner to save him, because in a sense, it's true. The sheep is lost; the sinner is lost. The lost sheep isn't in the flock; the lost sinner isn't in God's flock. The sheep is out on the mountainside about ready to die; the lost sinner is about ready to die & go to Hell. The sheep can't save itself; the lost sinner can't save himself. The shepherd had to save the sheep; Jesus Christ, the great shepherd (Heb 13v20, 1 Pet 2v25) has to save the sinner. You see, salvation is all through this passage so you might as well preach it, but it's NOT 'good' DOCTRINE (2 Tim 2v15). THE BOOK is not only 'profitable for doctrine' BUT 'for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness' as well (2 Tim 3v16).

Luke 15v7 - I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance. Again the 'sinner' of v7 is one of those bad people in v1+2, the 'just persons' would be the scribes & Pharisees who thought they kept the Law so that they didn't need to repent of anything. That's the immediate application. But you can apply that 'sinner' there to ANY sinner who gets saved. Look at what Paul says in 1 Thes 2v19 For what is our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? Are not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at his coming? That's the 'crown of rejoicing' – it's a soul-winners crown (something NO Hyper-Dispensationalist will ever receive). There is such rejoicing in Heaven when a sinner gets saved. This verse is also a great verse for eternal security, as you don't hear of Heaven moaning & groaning that suddenly a saved person lost his salvation then got it back again... imagine all the 'ups & downs' THAT would cause in Heaven!

Why I get so many Christians writing to me, emailing & calling disagreeing with me on doctrine, all comes back to most of them not being dispensational therefore not being able to rightly DIVIDE the Scriptures correctly (2 Tim 2v15). That's it! Like someone has said "Get Israel in the right position & you'll get your doctrine right"... there's a lot of truth in that!

The Blood

I've included the following article as another proof that evolution is totally a 'religion' that requires blind FAITH to believe something so **stupid**. Read this & ask yourself where the intelligence came from to stop your cut from bleeding? The blood is amazing & your body with all its systems is an incredible design. Evolution is a fairy story believed by people who can't think for themselves, like Richard 'The Dork' Dawkins & his ilk. Our God of creation is unfathomable in so many things, He is right on everything & perfect in all His ways. Man is just a rebellious imbecilic oaf who, because of pride, thinks he is right all the time. God's fingerprints are everywhere all over this world & universe, you've got to be blind not to see them.

Parts of the Blood

Our blood has two main parts – blood cells and plasma. The plasma is the liquid part of the blood. It is mainly water. It contains proteins, fats, salt, and other substances. Some of the proteins are important in blood clotting.

The blood cells are red cells, white cells, and platelets. Red blood cells carry oxygen to all parts of the body. White blood cells help fight infection. Platelets are tiny cells that have a big job in stopping bleeding. Proteins in the blood called clotting factors work to form a clot. In order to understand bleeding disorders, you have to know how the proteins and the platelets in the blood work together.

Our bodies make platelets inside the marrow of our bones. Platelets are disc shaped cells that are so small they can only be seen with a microscope. They are less than

half the size of a red blood cell. One drop of blood contains tens of thousands of platelets. About 70% of your body's platelets float around in your bloodstream. The other 30% are stored in an organ behind the stomach called the spleen. Each platelet travels in the bloodstream for seven to ten days. Then, if it has not been used to make a blood clot, cells in the spleen and liver destroy it. Every day 200 billion new platelets enter the bloodstream to take the place of those that are used or destroyed.

Stopping Bleeding

Blood travels around inside your body through blood vessels. These include <u>veins</u>, <u>arteries</u>, and <u>capillaries</u>. You can think of the blood vessels as pipes and tubes carrying blood to all parts of your body. When one of these pipes is damaged, the blood can spill out. Sometimes this happens on the outside when your skin is cut or scratched. Sometimes it happens just under the skin, causing a bruise. Other times the blood can be leaking out of a blood vessel inside the body. In all cases, the body must work to stop the leak and repair the pipe. **First, the blood vessel gets smaller** The first thing the body does is make the blood vessel smaller so less blood is going through it and leaking out. Muscles in the wall of the blood vessel make this happen.

Next, a platelet plug is made

The next step in stopping the bleeding is making a platelet plug. A platelet plug is a temporary patch over the leak. Three things must happen to make a good platelet plug: adhesion, activation and secretion, and aggregation. If there is a problem with any of these, a person is more likely to bleed.

Platelet Adhesion

In order to make a plug, the platelets floating in the blood must stick to the torn wall of the blood vessel. This is called adhesion.

Blood vessels are lined with smooth cells called <u>endothelial cells</u>. When the blood vessel is torn, the blood comes in contact with the substance under the endothelial cells. This substance is called <u>collagen</u>. Platelets floating by in the blood are attracted to collagen. They quickly move to the site of the injury.

In order for the platelets to stick to the collagen, they need a "glue." The "glue" that sticks platelets to the collagen is a protein in the blood called Von Willebrand Factor (VWF). The Von Willebrand Factor (VWF) attaches to the platelet at certain places on the platelet's surface. These places are called receptors.

Von Willebrand Factor is stored in the endothelial cells lining the blood vessels. The endothelial cells release the VWF into the blood.

Activation and Secretion

After the platelets stick to the collagen where the blood vessel is torn, they change their shape. Each platelet changes from a smooth disk to a ball shape with long arms that can reach out to other platelets. This is called platelet activation. Activated platelets can stick to each other and to clotting proteins in the blood.

Inside each platelet are storage spaces called granules. When the platelet changes shape, chemicals inside the granules are pushed out into the bloodstream. This is called secretion. These chemicals from the granules signal other platelets to come and help. The chemicals allow the next step in forming a platelet plug, aggregation, to happen.

Aggregation

To form a <u>platelet plug</u>, the platelets have to stick to each other as well as to the blood vessel. This is called platelet aggregation. The platelets form a clump that plugs the hole in the blood vessel.

When platelets can stick to the blood vessel (adhesion), change shape and signal other platelets to come help (activation and secretion), and stick to each other (aggregation), a good platelet plug is made. Though it is a complex process, it normally only takes seconds. A platelet plug is only a temporary fix. It can't last long on its own. A fibrin clot is needed.

Finally, a fibrin clot is formed

A fibrin clot is a good, strong patch over a hole in a blood vessel. It is normally enough to stop the bleeding completely. Proteins in the blood called clotting factors work together to make the fibrin clot. Twelve clotting factors are named with Roman numerals (I, II, III, IV, V, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XIII).

The clotting factors work together to make threads of a protein called fibrin. The fibrin threads weave over the platelet plug to make a strong clot. The body then has time to heal the blood vessel. When it is no longer needed, the body gets rid of the fibrin clot.

To Review

Bleeding is supposed to stop after three things happen:

The injured blood vessel gets smaller to let less blood through.

Platelets rush to the site and stick together to form a platelet plug. The platelets do this

through <u>adhesion</u>, <u>activation</u> and <u>secretion</u>, and <u>aggregation</u>.

Clotting factor proteins in the blood work together to make threads of fibrin. The <u>fibrin</u> weaves itself into a clot over the platelet plug. This makes a strong seal.

For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.

Lev 17v11

Stubbornness

1 Sam 15v23 For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king.

Ps 78v6-8 That the generation to come might know them, even the children which should be born; who should arise and declare them to their children: That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments: And might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation; a generation that set not their heart aright, and whose spirit was not stedfast with God. More & more I see it, especially with the elderly. They get set in their ways & that's it. This is why it is very difficult for an elderly person to get saved, they have been rebelling against God all their lives, so why should they change at the end. Isn't it near impossible to even help some old people, they won't let you. You could make their life so much easier for them, but they will not let you do it, why is that... stubbornness, PRIDE! It's not only sad, it's tragic. Stubbornness can be good & bad, the majority being bad I suppose. Are you like this? Are you willing to let go, let other people come first? Are you teachable & a good listener or does pride keep getting in the way. Do you even want to change your character? May the Lord help us all to change & be the people that He wants us to be rather than being conformed to the world, carnality & pride.

When was the last time you apologised?

Humility (1 Pet 5v5) is seldom seen among Christians today, let alone those who make poor decisions, run away, leave, make out they are right in everything & everyone is against them. When was the last time you were wrong & you swallowed your pride & apologised? Exactly! It's hard to 'play the man' isn't it. Do you know why so many Christians leave so many churches & just drift from one to the next? It's all because of pride; they think they are right & will leave when something doesn't go their way. They will do this at every church they visit & will never stay for more than a year or so. Oh, they'll pretend to be godly by saying all the right things & duping the leader & people there, but really they are just unstable arrogant immature Christians who don't know what humility is neither how to apologise when they are wrong. This is Christianity today!

Grace occurs in 159 verses (See TfT! issue 49 page 11)

The word 'grace' has so many different meanings, it's a word full of depth. Now, I want to ask you a question... 'When is it time to leave, go, get out?' If you are in a church & you disagree over 'one thing', but the doctrine is sound 99% of the time, do you leave over that 'one thing'? Why is it that most Christians do? Immaturity & pride I guess. You throw the baby out with the bathwater, as they say. I find it quite amazing that over just one issue, that really isn't that important, although the injured party thinks it is, a person will leave the church & never come back. That is immaturity personified, & I find it staggering, that's why I say most Christians are very childish & never seem to grow up.



The Gap FACT! (Part EIGHT)

Continuing from the book 'The Gap Fact' by Perry Demopoulos... Gen 1v2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

"Void" - Now let's go to the next word of importance in Genesis 1:2, "void." It also has a negative connotation to it just as "without form." Again take your Bible and find in your concordance the word "void."



Now to get the added revelation which opens up Genesis 1:2 turn to the next time the word "void" is written by the Holy Spirit of God. It is in Numbers 30:12 But if her husband hath utterly MADE THEM VOID on the day he heard them; then whatsoever proceeded out of her lips concerning her vows, or concerning the bond of her soul, shall not stand: her husband hath made them void; and the LORD shall forgive her. Look how the phrase "made them void" is mentioned in verse 12, 13 and 15. The meaning is simple. You don't even have to explain it to understand it. In the context (vvs. 10, 11) the vow or a bond of a wife stands (v. 11) until her husband MAKES it void. Adam "blew it" here. He "gave in" and allowed Eve's words to stand. Satan tempted Eve to get her to fall to get to the head of the home, Adam. We can apply what was mentioned under our first point to this second point, that is, that the earth BECAME void because again, Jeremiah mentions that the earth, "it was without form, and void..." Here in Numbers 30:12, what the woman says stands until the husband makes it void. That is, it BECOMES void by the husband. He is to practice what God Himself did. He made the earth "without form and void..." because of the words and intentions of the "cherub that coverth." (Isa. 14:12, 13; Ezek. 28:15). Satan sinned and God judged the heavens and the earth, He made them void. The man is to make void anything that is said or intended by the wife that is against the word of God. Job did that when his wife told him to "curse God and die" (Job 2:9) He said, "Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? Shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips" (v. 10). He made her words void. That was very easy to figure out!!! The earth BECAME void, according to the Authorized Version of the King James Bible; no Greek, no Hebrew languages no commentaries, no ministries were necessary for the interpretation. The words of God are self-interpreting and the written revelation of God Almighty is that her words are MADE void whereas they were NOT void at one time until they are MADE void, that is, they BECOME void. "O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out!" (Romans 11:33). The next time the word "void" is mentioned is in Deuteronomy 32:28 "For they are a nation void of counsel, neither is there any understanding in them." Note the reason why Israel BECAME a nation void of counsel was because of SIN. Psalm 89:39 Thou hast made void the covenant of thy servant: thou hast profaned his crown by casting it to the ground. The reason that they made void the covenant was because of SIN. The word "VOID" according to the Holy Bible is a NEGATIVE word." And for Kent Hovind, Mr. Tabb, Henry Morris and others simply don't know what they are talking about when dealing with the creation God, that the earth just "happened to be without form and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep." Let's continue to allow God to speak for Himself concerning the word "VOID" shall we? Or are you going to continue to be a blind, willfully ignorant Laodicean Christian and reject absolute light, PROGRESSIVE revelation and truth of the words of God? Psalm 119:126 It is time for thee, LORD, to work: FOR THEY HAVE MADE VOID thy law. The reason they have made void the law is because of SIN. The law was not made void at one time but it BECAME void. They made it void. Proverbs 7:7 And beheld among the simple ones, I discerned among the youths, a young man void of understanding, The reason why the simple ones are void of understanding is because of SIN. Are you beginning to notice something here? SIN is the reason why there was a "void." Look at Proverbs 10:13 and see who gets punished with a rod, "him that is void of understanding." Isaiah 55:11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. "And I will MAKE VOID the counsel of Judah and Jerusalem in this place; and I will cause them to FALL by the sword before their enemies, and by the hands of them that seek their lives: and their carcases will I give to be meat for the fowls of the heaven, and for the beasts of the earth" (Jer. 19:7) Notice how the words "void" and "fall" are coupled together in this verse. They are both NEGATIVE words. So it only confirms the facts that when the earth "was without form and void" is was when Satan fell and God judged him and spoiled what he rightfully had rule over. Notice carefully the revelation given by Nahum - "She is empty, (NEGATIVE) and VOID, (NEGATIVE) and waste: (NEGATIVE) and the heart melteth, (NEGATIVE) and the knees smite together, (NEGATIVE) and much pain is in all loins, (NEGATIVE) and the faces of them all gather blackness" (NEGATIVE) (Nahum 2:10). There is no possible way to say that when God created the heaven and the earth that He didn't do it right. He did it right, without error and without void. But the earth BECAME "without form and VOID" in Genesis 1:2 according to Jeremiah 4:23. "But the heavens and the earth which are now" (2 Pet. 3:7) will become without form and VOID in the Tribulation (according to Jeremiah's prophecy) after the Church is raptured (1 Thess. 4:16-18) which is a foretaste of a total dissolving of the heavens and the earth at the end of the Millennium (2 Pet. 3:7b, 10-13). Notice again that for us to come to the Biblical interpretation of the scriptures we simply took a concordance and ran references on the word "void." We allowed God to speak up for Himself. He is very capable of doing that. When it comes to interpreting the scriptures the Christian should be exercised in allowing the scriptures to speak for themselves in other

portions of scriptures rather than "butting in" and speaking before hearing a matter "He that answereth a matter before he heareth it, it is folly and shame unto him" (Proverbs 18:13). Now we will not labour our point but we cannot leave this matter of what the Lord makes without discussing Isaiah 24:1, "Behold, the LORD MAKETH THE EARTH EMPTY, and MAKETH IT WASTE, and turneth it upside down, and scattereth abroad the inhabitants thereof." Notice in this verse that it is the Lord that "maketh the earth empty... and waste." Now a more important question to ask would be WHY would God do that? It certainly is not because in His creation He started out with a blob of clay and then began to form a nice vase as was previously mentioned. In the context all becomes very clear; it is because of SIN, and God's JUDGEMENT upon sin that God "maketh the earth empty, and maketh it waste..." Verses 2-12 speak of "usury" (v. 2) "the land shall be utterly EMPTIED" (v. 3), "the haughty people..." (v. 4), "The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; BECAUSE THEY HAVE TRANSGRESSED THE LAWS, CHANGED THE ORDINANCE, BROKEN THE EVERLASTING COVENANT" (v. 5), "CONFUSION..." (v. 10), "ALL JOY IS DARKENED" (v. 11). To overlook the revelation of God here and the similarities between this passage and Jeremiah 4:23 concerning the reason WHY the earth "that then was" (2 Pet. 3:6) "was without form and void" (Gen. 1:2) and the "heavens and the earth which are now (2 Pet. 3:7) will be in such an awful condition (Jer. 4:23) is to pass by monumental proportions of revelation of the scriptures. And that is exactly the case with many of our 'creationist' brethren. When you stumble over one verse to prove a point (Rom. 5:12) all other relating subjects and verses will become perverted to justify the first point.

What are you failing in?

Are you failing as a husband or wife, a friend, carrying responsibility, as a Christian etc.? We all fail at times in our lives, we give in to the flesh & we fall. We all quit when we really should be taking a stand & fighting. Oftentimes we let things go rather than sorting it all out. There are so many situations that this can relate to in our lives of course. So if we are failing in some area, what are we doing about it? If you leave it, without dealing with it, you're doing no one any good, including yourself. There are times in our life when we need to man up, stand up & take control, & do what is right, but on numerous occasions we don't, we fail. Are you failing in life at present? Have you poured out your heart to God asking for His guidance? If not, how do you think you'll get out or over the situation? Are you a good mother / father to your children, are you failing them because of your lack of discipline; do you just keep saying 'yes' & give in to them? Then you are failing as a parent. Are you teaching your children the Scriptures? 2 Tim 3v15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. Are you failing to make the right decisions, therefore you've got yourself 'in a rut' or a hole, that you're fining hard to get out of? You know, one thing I love about being a Christian is this, you can fail a million times but STILL there is hope & light at the end of the tunnel. There is always a way back to God & to do what is right, but you have to make that conscience decision to get on that path. There are many things in life we just can't cope with on our own, even though we try, it's in these times we need to just run back to the Lord crying out for help.


We don't take any day for granted, we always try do get something out of it for the Lord no matter how mundane it appears to be. Try to enjoy every day.



I begged, pleaded with God, sought God with such an urgency, fasted & prayed oftentimes, cried out to Him that He would take Donna's arthritis away; do you know what happened? He answered my prayer, but NOT as I wanted or had hoped for. Donna still has arthritis. Some Pentecostals will say 'You lacked faith to believe in a healing miracle'... to which I answer "Go soak your head in a bucket!" Why didn't God heal Donna? Because it's His will that she lives with arthritis until the Rapture... He knows what is best for her. Now read 2 Cor 12 ALL OF IT. Get the picture? If you don't, you don't understand the Scriptures neither the will of God. Healing IS in the atonement, BUT, you don't get all the benefits of the atonement down here. At the Rapture, Donna will be healed. Pentecostals are LIARS! Why do I say that? Because in every Pentecostal church on planet earth a large portion of the congregation are ill, sick, diseased, have cancer, need a walking stick, are going for operations (which is a joke if they really believed what they preach & teach), die early, plus a whole host of other ailments, & all Pentecostals can do is dismiss it, make out healing is coming, make up some excuse of why they are not seeing someone healed.
