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Time for Truth!

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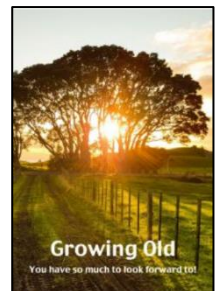
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Trying to do what is right!

Luke 12v15-21 And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth. And he spake a parable unto them, saying, The ground of a certain rich man brought forth plentifully: And he thought within himself, saying, What shall I do, because I have no room where to bestow my fruits? And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater; and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods. And I will say to my soul, Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry. But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided? So is he that layeth up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God. Being in the 'business world' I see greed everywhere. Customers & Principals alike, are all very greedy at times, trying to squeeze that very last penny from anyone & everyone they can. *I hate it!* Accumulating wealth & building up stacks of money just to sit there seems so pointless to me. I find that Christians are some of the *worst* people I know to part with 'the Lord's money', it's sacred to them. It really does amaze me just how tight some Christians are, & then they wonder why the Lord isn't blessing their endeavours! (Prov 11v25, 2 Cor 9v7). 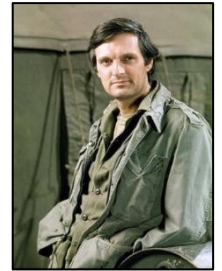
Why quit?

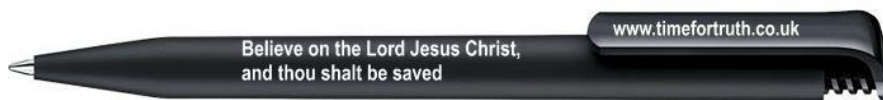
The nonsense of NOT-Welcome Hall Calvinistic Cult 'Church' in Bromsgrove!

Madalyn Murray O'Hair (April 13, 1919 – September 29, 1995) was an American activist supporting atheism and separation of church and state. In 1963 she founded American Atheists and served as its president to 1986, after which her son **Jon Garth Murray** succeeded her. She created the first issues of American Atheist Magazine. **Kidnapping and murder** - On August 27, 1995, O'Hair, her son Garth Murray, and granddaughter Robin Murray O'Hair disappeared from their home and office. Federal agents for the FBI and the IRS, along with the police, concluded that Waters and his accomplices had kidnapped all three Murray/O'Hair family members, forced them to withdraw the missing funds, gone on several shopping sprees with their money and credit cards, and killed and dismembered all three people. **She gets**

murdered & 'cut up'!



Her other son becomes a Christian!



William J. "Bill" Murray III (born May 25, 1946) is an American author, **Baptist minister**, and social conservative lobbyist who serves as the chairman of the Religious Freedom Coalition, a non-profit organization in Washington, D.C. It lobbies Congress on issues related to aiding Christians in Islamic and Communist countries. **The son of the late Madalyn Murray O'Hair**, known as an **atheist activist**, Murray was named as the plaintiff in his mother's challenge to mandatory prayer and Bible reading in public schools. After it was consolidated and heard as Abington School District v. Schempp (1963), the US Supreme Court ruled that mandatory Bible reading was unconstitutional. **After becoming a Christian in 1980**, Murray published a memoir, My Life Without God (1982), about his spiritual journey. **God wins & gets the glory as always!**

Trying to change the world? You're wasting your time!

When I got saved on May 4th 1989, I wanted to change the world. Now I know that's futile. Every dispensation ends in failure & we are at the very end of this one, hence why the church is in the worst state ever (apostasy), sodomites, feminists & Muslims rule our country, & there is no such thing as 'boys & girls' anymore, schools teach everything BUT truth, evolution is taught as 'fact', & women's 'rights' are destroying *them*. We are in the biggest MESS in history! So what can we do? I could really get depressed thinking about all of this, but I have so much hope... the Lord Jesus Christ is coming back very soon to sort it all out. My 'job' is to get as close to Him as I can & stay there, read, study & teach His word, & reach as many lost sinners with the Gospel as I can, all the while, keeping one eye on the sky looking for the Rapture. Don't talk to me about useless politics, Brexit, the financial crisis, business, or any other worldly problem that man has created, talk to me about the future, the return of Christ, the hope of Heaven, & what the Bible says. So many Christians get caught up with 'the world' & they forget that it's 'doomed' (1 John 2v15, Mat 6v24, Rom 12v2, Gal 1v10, James 4v4, 2 Pet 3v8-14 etc.) I can't think of anything more boring & a complete waste of time than politics, business & finance, & seeking after the world through a career, fame & fortune. Like I keep saying, PRIDE destroys, living for the FLESH is useless (Rom 7 + 8 READ THEM!) & seeking your own desires in life - 'delusion'. Living for the Lord is the ONLY way to live, which brings with it, purpose, peace, happiness, joy, love & belonging. I don't belong anywhere, only with the Lord, & I can't wait to see Him. I've seen too many Christians go off the rails, getting caught up with the world & it's 'attractions & distractions' & they just can't see it, they are self-deluded, blind as bats & full of pride. In desperation they try to look like the world & be a part of it. I want none of it. As long as I can pay the bills, invest in the ministry, & reach lost sinners with the Gospel, having good Christian fellowship, I'm having a great time. Now look up these verses, & if they don't have an impact on you, you're backslidden – Gal 1v4, Phil 2v15, Acts 2v40, Mark 8v38, Luke 9v41, 1 John 5v19, John 17v14-17, 1 John 2v16, Jer 5v23, Deut 32v5, (see also TMY2 pg 386), Gal 1v10, Mat 23v2-7, Acts 5v29, Rom 3v4, Acts 4v18-20, 1 Thes 2v4, James 4v4. Now if you looked up all those verses you had quite a Bible study there, plus you will wake up to the reality that living for yourself is pointless. Col 3v17 **And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.** See also Col 3v23.

What was the forbidden fruit?

In the Garden of Eden (Gen 2v8) we find *three* trees listed...

- 1) Gen 2v9 – The tree of Life
- 2) Gen 2v17 – The tree of Knowledge of Good & Evil
- 3) Gen 3v7 – The Fig Tree
- 4) We also find 'thorns & thistles' – Gen 3v18

Now it's very interesting that we have a 'match' in Judges chapter 9...

- 1) Judg 9v8 – The Olive Tree (Rom 11v14-24, Zech 4)
- 2) Judg 9v12 – The Vine Tree (Grape) (Num 6v4)
- 3) Judg 9v10 – The Fig Tree
- 4) Judg 9v14 – The 'bramble' (thorns & thistles)

There is one fruit that is forbidden to eat in the Bible – Gen 2v16+17, Num 6v2-4.

Mat 26v26-29 – grape juice represents blood (Mark 14v24, Deut 32v13+14).

Blood is forbidden to eat *before* the Law (Gen 9v4), *during* the Law (Lev 17v14), & *after* the Law (Acts 15v20+28+29).

So, the two items that are forbidden to eat are blood & grapes.

The first two public miracles in the OT & NT were...

- 1) Exod 4v8+9 (blood)
- 2) John 2v9-11 (grape juice) Isa 65v8, Num 13v23+24

Water, blood & grape juice are connected & speak of 'life' – Gen 1v20, 2 Kings 3v22, Gen 49v10+11, Deut 32v13+14.

It is interesting that the Lord's resurrected body had no blood in it – Cf. the first Adam with the last Adam - Gen 2v23, Luke 24v39.

Just by comparing Scripture with Scripture, we can follow the pattern & see that the 'Tree of Life' was a 'Vine Tree' which represents blood – Lev 17v11.

Isn't it strange how children grow up thinking that the forbidden fruit was an apple, when all along it was a grape!

Let's stay in Genesis for a moment & look at Adam & Eve & run another great little Bible study...

Gen 2v21+22 -note the word 'sleep' & look up the following verses – John 11v9-14, Mat 27v52, 1 Cor 15v6+51, 1 Thes 4v14, Acts 7v60 – they associate sleep with death, Adam died (just like Jonah died & went to Hell, also a type of Christ Mat 12v40 cf. Jonah 1v17-2v1-6). He died for his wife, just as Christ died for His bride, the church – Eph 5v20-25. Both Adam & Christ were opened in the side (John 19v34) for a bride, & Christ's side opened was the fifth wound. God took one of Adam's ribs, which would have been the fifth (2 Sam 2v23, 2 Sam 4v5+6), 'five' being the number of death of course (See Christian Soldier's Battle Notes Volume One page 111+112). See how it all makes sense just by comparing Scripture with Scripture?

Take away YouTube & what have they got?

Imagine if YouTube suddenly disappeared, what would most of these Christians do without their channel? You see, most of these YouTube-'stay in your house & look into the camera'- Christians, have nothing OUTSIDE of YouTube. They have no ministry & are doing very little, if anything for the Lord. Look at people like Pfenny, Hunter, Breaker etc. all they do is YouTube videos, they think this is 'ministry' & God is pleased with them... self-delusion is a terrible thing isn't it! If YouTube vanished tomorrow, what would YOU do, what ministry do YOU have? It's quite incredible how many hours a day Christians spend watching or making YouTube videos rather than working & serving the Lord. Beware of becoming a housebound sofa-sitting Christian. Your bedroom is NOT the mission-field, unless you have a disability that is & you can't get out, this I can understand.

2018 has been quite the year. As Bible believing Christians looking at the world, we can see that there have been a multitude of events that go far beyond the norm. This world is becoming worse and worse in every aspect. Society is becoming more Satanic, the politics of our world are becoming more and more bizarre, our speech is becoming more censored than ever and the environment is becoming more polluted and spoiled amongst a whole host of other things. What terrifies me is the speed of which this descent into darkness is happening. The Lord must be coming back soon. In the UK, we have seen a whole host of events this year. In London, whilst the media's spotlight was upon the marriage of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle (who cares???) we see on the news how almost daily there is murder, rape, acid attacks and robbery. The love of many is certainly waxing cold and yet we're constantly bombarded with messages encouraging us to "be happy", to "think positively", to "consider your mental health" and to "live your best life now". 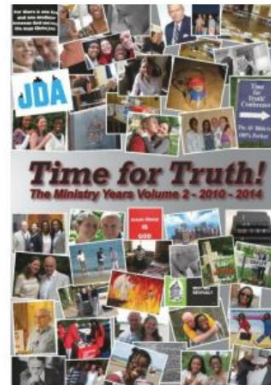
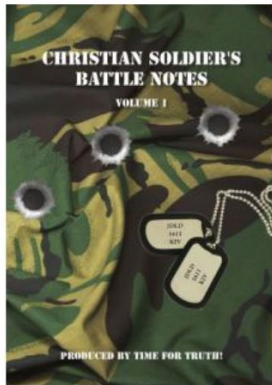

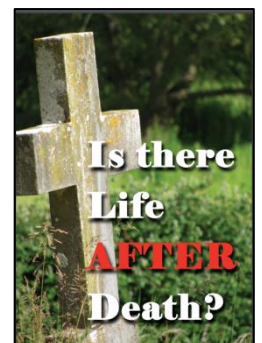

Moron of the Year 2018

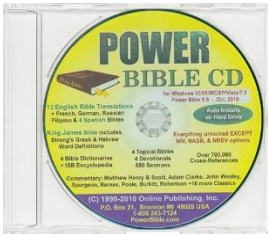

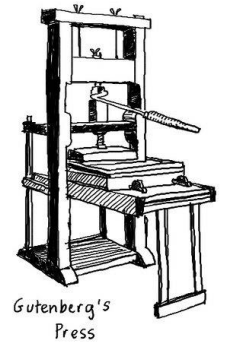

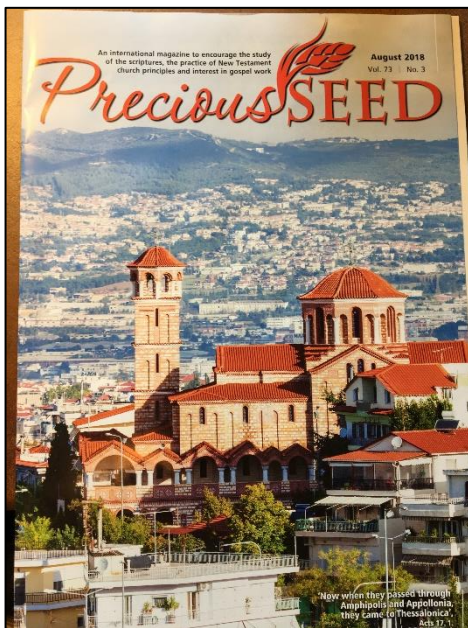

People who just don't listen...

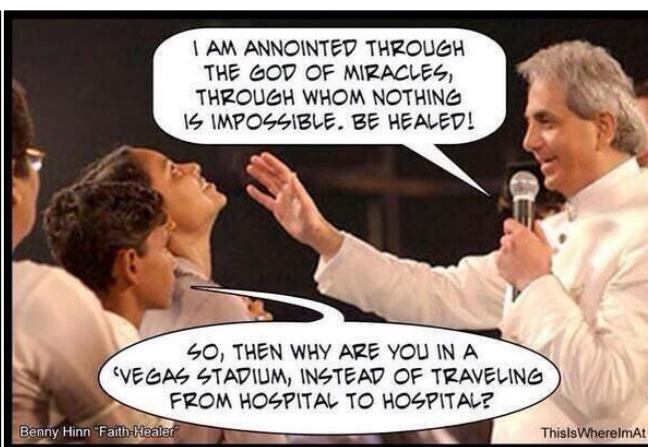
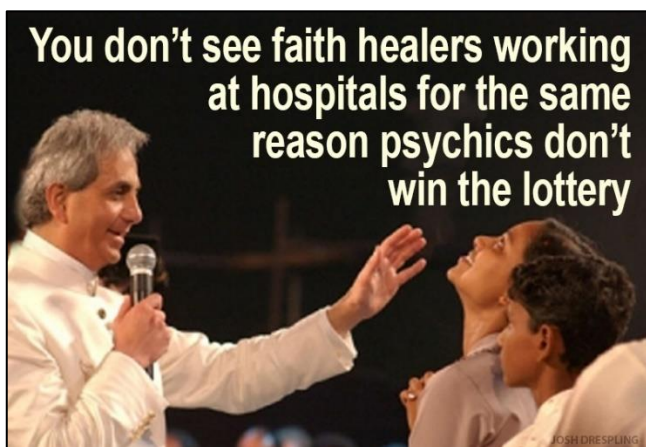

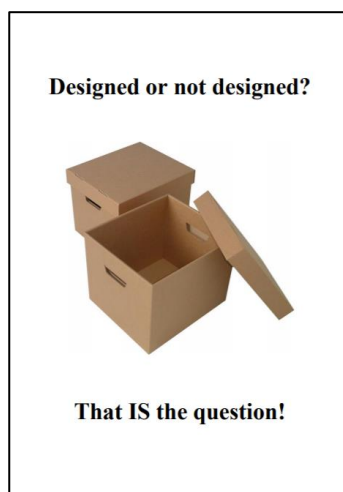
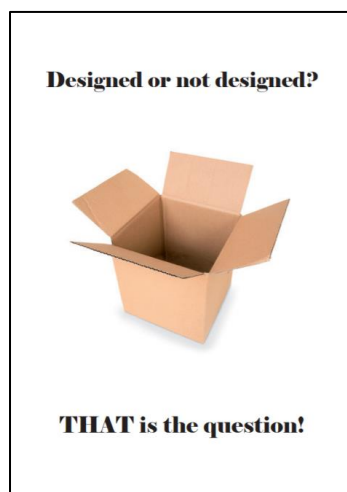
Time for Truth! CD Sermon Ministry

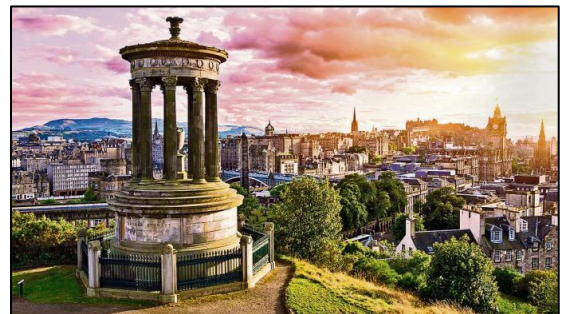

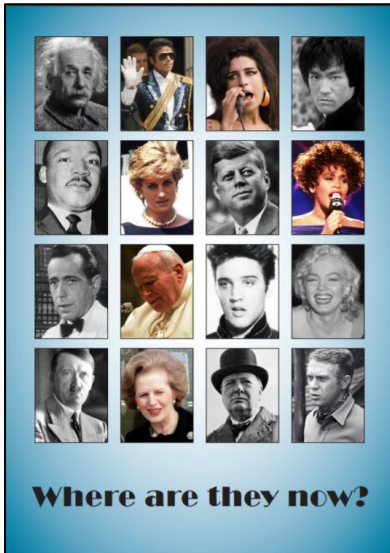
Re:- JW's this is a strategy on witnessing to JW's that Sister Riplinger set out in *Blind Guides* p 42, her emphases. She says that this method is very effective. The AV1611 must be used. I've reproduced it below.

- Point the JW to Rev. 1:1 and have him read: "*I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last*":
- Ask him "*Who is 'the first and the last'? Who is speaking?*"
- Every JW (or Jewish person even slightly versed in scripture) will say, "*Jehovah,*" based on Old Testament verses such as Isaiah 44:6 or 48:12 which say, "*I am the first, and I am the last...*" "*I am he...*"
- Then point him to Rev. 1:18, "*I am he that liveth and was dead; and behold, I am alive for evermore.*"
- Ask him "*When was Jehovah dead?*"
- They *then* realize that Jesus Christ was "*God manifest in the flesh*" (1 Tim. 3:16).
- This technique has been used to lead more JW's to Christ than any other. It works every time I've done it (Sister Riplinger's testimony about the method).

What are you worried about?

Money? Your health? Dying? (Heb 2v14+15). What about your relationship, your family? How about your job? At times we all get worried & anxious about certain things, it's hard not to. There is a lovely verse in the Scriptures that says this... **Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.** 1 Pet 5v7. Do you talk to the Lord about everything? (Ps 62v8). That's what you need to do, talk to the Lord, tell Him everything, all your thoughts, worries, hurt, pain & disappointments etc. tell Him everything. Want some more lovely encouraging verses? Look up these... Mat 11v28, Ps 37v5, Ps 55v22, Mat 6v25, Phil 4v6, Heb 13v5. Life can be full of stresses & worries, that's why as Christians we should be seeking the Lord in everything we do. Running a business can really have it's challenges, no one pays us a wage, so we don't have any 'security' in the sense of receiving a steady salary. If we don't sell, we don't eat! Every day we are praying & trusting in the Lord to make our business a success & to bring in the necessary money to pay the bills. I thank God for each day. We clocked up over 123,000 miles in two & a half year's, so we've got to change the car soon. Try getting a lease on a car when you are doing 50,000+ miles a year, this can be stressful too, but we just ask the Lord to guide us in every decision we make. Walking through life making all kinds of decisions can cause us to get anxious, but it should also teach us to keep talking & trusting the Lord in everything. Don't quit! Don't give up! Be honest & tell it as it is. Too many Christians make excuses & lie rather than face up to reality. Failing is not always a bad thing... it teaches you something. Some of the most successful businessmen in life were failures all the way until they hit the right time. Being a Christian, I see 'success' in life differently. Doing the Lord's will is the most successful thing you can achieve in life, the question is this, are you in the will of God?

We all ought to watch the way we speak to one another - Col 4v6 **Let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.** Ecc 10v12 **The words of a wise man's mouth are gracious; but the lips of a fool will swallow up himself.** The way I speak to Donna can affect her for the rest of the day, all because I said something in a certain way. Recently I have received a number of letters from a very arrogant Bible 'corrector' who is attacking the KJV in one of my tracts. The way he wrote to me was very patronising, so much so that I have sent him a number of very sarcastic responses full of 'barb' & ridicule. He hasn't been spoken to like that ever, & is trying to hold it together, even though he is about to boil over anytime now. You see, I detest, *utterly detest*, arrogant Christians especially arrogant Bible 'correctors', so much so, that I will treat them with the contempt I feel they deserve. All of them run for the bushes after the normal three or four letters, some try to stick it out, none of them do. I'm NOT saying that this is the right way of dealing with arrogant Christians... *but it sure feels good!* I will be as loving, caring & helpful as anyone, but if you suddenly 'smack me in the mouth', expect some retaliation! The Lord was the perfect man who could take it, oftentimes I can't it seems. Trying to live these verses is a nightmare for me... 1 Pet 2v21-23 **For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:** The Lord is amazing, so amazing how He treated all those around Him, whether friends or enemies. The more I know about human nature the more I don't like it... this flesh gets right on my nerves (Rom 7). One day I'm not going to have any more problems with the flesh, what a day that's going to be, & one day, I'm not going to have nutcase Christians emailing me with their pathetic gibberish trying to justify their own existence... *can't wait!!!*

Answer not a fool according to his folly, lest thou also be like unto him.

Answer a fool according to his folly, lest he be wise in his own conceit. Prov 26v4+5

The Gap FACT! (Part NINE)

Continuing from the book 'The Gap Fact' by Perry Demopoulos... Gen 1v2 **And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.**

'Darkness' - Now we come to a word that also has a negative connotation to it, the word, "darkness." In Genesis 1:2 the word "darkness" is mentioned for the first time. In theology, concerning Biblical interpretation there is what is called, 'the Principle of First Mention.' That means that once that word is mentioned it will basically give you what kind of connotation it will have throughout the rest of the Bible. The second time "darkness" is mentioned is immediately in verse 4, "And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness." He saw that the light, "that it was good," but not the darkness. He "divided the light FROM the darkness." Verse four shows that darkness is not good because God did not call the darkness good as He did the light. On the second day when God created the firmament to divide the waters so that there would be waters above the firmament and waters below the firmament, He does not say that it was good as He said on all the other days of creation. A rather ominous omission, wouldn't you say? Why is that? That is where principalities, powers, the rulers of the darkness of this world, spiritual wickedness in high places are (Eph. 6:12). The Bible says that we are to "rightly [divide] the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15). Right in the context of Genesis 1:2 there is a DIVISION. If you don't make that division you are disobeying God in matters of Bible interpretation.

First Mention Principle of "thick darkness" In your Bible, the first time "thick darkness" is mentioned is in Exodus 10:22. It gives you the general idea what it is about – judgment. To think that "darkness" is a part of creation in Genesis 1:2 and not judgment is to slide over a negative truth. Here is your first revelation in Holy writ about "thick darkness," – "And Moses stretched forth his hand toward heaven; and there was a thick darkness in all the land of Egypt three days:" Now what do you make of that? I'll tell you what you do with it, just BELIEVE IT! The judgment here is simply a foretaste of the "outer darkness" of 2 Peter 2:17 and it is one of the judgments which is destined to fall on the earth during the Great Tribulation (Rev. 16:10) because the book of Exodus will be repeated, "And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain."

For more absolute revelation concerning "thick darkness" (which many of your "Funny-mentalists" missed) let's go to Exodus 19:14-18. Read the verses CAREFULLY and notice – 1. "Moses went down from the mount..." (v. 14). 2. "...there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount..." (v. 16). 3. "And MOUNT SINAI WAS ALTOGETHER ON A SMOKE, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly" (v. 18). Verse 18 is what really knocks Tabb "out of the race." Mount Sinai was "altogether on a SMOKE..." Why was that Mr. Tabb? Well, we will tell you why. Because "...the LORD descended upon it in a FIRE..." If that weren't enough revelation for some of our blind brethren, Moses continues to write under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit the following words, "and the SMOKE thereof ascended as the smoke of a FURNACE..." You see, darkness is not only a part of God's creation AS A RESULT OF JUDGMENT AND SIN but also as a result of either fire or water and clouds. Here in Exodus 19, God was letting the nation Israel know that "God is a consuming FIRE" (Deut. 4:24; 6:25; 9:3; Heb. 12:29). The Jews were SCARED OF DYING (JUDGMENT) at that mount. Look at Exodus 20:18-21 – 1. "But let not God speak with us, lest we die" (v. 21). 2. "And all the people saw the thunders, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw it, they removed, and stood afar off" (v. 18). 3. "And the people stood afar off, and Moses drew near unto the THICK DARKNESS where God was" (v. 21). Now let's look at Deuteronomy 5:22, 23. This verse ought to settle this issue once and for all. Notice that the darkness is because of the fire that burned – "And it came to pass, when ye heard the voice out of the midst of the darkness, (FOR THE MOUNTAIN DID BURN WITH FIRE,) that ye came near unto me, even all the heads of your tribes, and your elders" (v. 23).

Family members are the HARDEST to win for the Lord, aren't they?

All you want is for your whole family to get saved & go to Heaven when they die or when the Rapture happens, yet so many of them are so anti-Christian it just amazes you how hard & nasty they can be, so hard-hearted. It's so sad & disappointing, you ONLY want THE BEST for them but they love their sin too much to want to change. They are so full of pride, self-importance & think that they are right & you know nothing, that it seems impossible to even be able to talk to them about the Lord. Why on earth would someone hate Jesus Christ so much? Stop & think about that for a while. John 15v18-23 **If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you. If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you. Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also. But all these things will they do unto you for my name's sake, because they know not him that sent me. If I had not come and spoken unto them, they had not had sin: but now they have no cloke for their sin. He that hateth me hateth my Father also. John 7v7 The world cannot hate you; but me it hateth, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil.** Just keep praying & witnessing when you can.

Tracts... they are so important!

Every week we get responses from tracts! This week we had another three people email us because they had received a tract & wanted more details & information etc. Distributing Gospel tracts is one of the most important things a Christian can do. If you're scared of talking to someone because you don't feel confident enough, then tract distribution is the perfect ministry for you. Everywhere you go sow the seed of the word of God through tracts. Cartoon Chick tracts are excellent, but not all *adults* appreciate 'cartoons', as some find them condescending, & would respond better to a punchy adult written tract. There are all kinds of tracts you can use, *not just ours of course*, but no matter which ones you use, keep distributing them everywhere. It's a wonderful feeling knowing that you are sending these little 'missionaries' out all over the world. We try to encourage Christians everywhere to keep saturating their areas with Gospel tracts & pray that the Lord will break through into people's lives & save them.

I've messed up!

Who hasn't? I've messed up loads of times, still do! Making the right decisions is tough at times. It's easy to sin, & oftentimes pleasurable, until *afterwards* when the guilt kicks in. We all sin, even though we are saved, we STILL sin. 1 Cor 10v13 **There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.** But remember, you don't FALL INTO sin, you CHOOSE TO SIN! 1 Pet 5v9 **Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.** You & I are no different, the Devil knows our weaknesses. What may be a strength to you could be a weakness to me. You may be able to stand against certain sins that I find hard to do, & vice versa. We all have our Achilles Heel, & struggle with different things, but what we can take encouragement from is this, we all go through the same kind of things, you are NOT alone! 2 Pet 2v9 **The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished:** The closer we are to the Lord, the deeper we are in the Scriptures & the more we pray, will certainly help fight the sin in our lives. Acts 14v22 **Confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.** Tribulation will definitely come our way in all shapes & forms, & the key to dealing with it all is how close we are to the Lord in our daily Christian life. Acts 11v23 **Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.** Get as close to Jesus Christ as you can, seek depth in your walk with the Lord, & keep busy for Him... you've heard the sayings... 'The devil makes work for idle hands' & 'An idle mind is the devil's playground', this is so true. If you are NOT working & serving the Lord, you'll get up to things you know you shouldn't. Ecc 5v12 **The sleep of a labouring man is sweet, whether he eat little or much: but the abundance of the rich will not suffer him to sleep.** Ecc 4v5 **The fool foldeth his hands together, and eateth his own flesh.** 1 Tim 6v8 **And having food and raiment let us be therewith content.** We live in such a materialistic, worldly & consumer society, that it is hard to be content with what we have, but the following verses should certainly be read in regard to seeking after 'great things' (Jer 45v5) – Phil 4v11-13, Prov 30v8+9, 2 Cor 6v10, Mat 6v31-33, Ps 62v10, Heb 13v5, Prov 16v8, Prov 27v20, Luke 3v14, Ps 37v16, Prov 15v16.

Look at yourself!

Do you? **For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.** James 1v23+24. Do you ever think about how you sound when you talk to others? Do you ever think about how others see you? So many Christians just 'spout off' without even thinking about the repercussions & problems they are causing. Read Matthew 7.

We have a responsibility, look at the following verses & see the emphasis ON US... 1 Cor 11v28 **But let a man examine himself...** 2 Tim 2v15 **Study to shew thyself approved unto God...** Lev 20v7 **Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be ye holy: for I am the LORD your God.** 1 Pet 1v15 **But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;** 1 Pet 1v16 **Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.** The Bible is our Book on Life, & shows us how to live, but do we obey it? I want to be surrounded with people who really do love the Lord & put Him first. I don't want to 'compete' with Christians, I want to walk through life with a team of committed Christians around me serving the Lord & loving one another while doing so. I will not chase those that leave (Mark 10v17-25), as we are all adults & make our own decisions. You want to seek a career, go it alone, go ahead, but I will not chase you. We are all responsible for the way we live, & for our own actions. I want to put Jesus Christ above everything, my wife, friends, family, job, career, money, & everything else. Marilyn Monroe - 1926 - 1962. She took a high dose of barbiturates and put an end to the suffering.

Dana Plato - 1964 - 1999

She took a deadly combination of painkillers and muscle relaxants; her son, Tyler Lambert, also committed suicide in 2010, continuing the troubled legacy of the family.

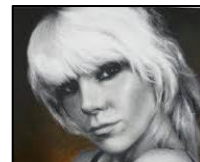


Ernest Hemingway - 1899 - 1961.

Hemingway suffered from a severe depression. He tried to cure his depression with alcohol, as he was famous for his love for booze. And in the end, he decided to end the suffering and committed suicide by shooting himself.

Wendy O. Williams - 1949 - 1998

As a teenager who felt there is something bigger out there than college and university degree, she left school to form a rock band, the Plasmatics. With her Mohawk haircut, Wendy quickly became a poster child for rebellious movement. Years later, in 1998, the singer took her life with a single gunshot to the head. Part of her suicide note read... '*For me, much of the world makes no sense...*'



To think, all of the above have influenced millions of people around the world. They had an impact on those around them, a responsibility, given their 'privileged' position of being in the limelight, yet what did they do with their lives? Without Jesus Christ nothing really makes sense. Life is pointless without the Lord guiding you. Life goes by so quickly, one minute you're leaving school or college, next you've hit your 30's, 40's & 50's. It is so sad to see so many of these famous people being sucked into this plastic world, thinking that fame & fortune is everything. By the time they realise it's not, they are dying. Life is so precious, many are clinging onto it right now as you are reading this, trying to stay here, yet they can feel life ebbing away. Hospitals, Hospices & Homes, are full of people who are dying. They are living out their final moments with just memories, regrets, joys, uncertainty, plus a whole load more of different emotions. I can't even imagine what it's like coming to the end of your life without Jesus Christ at the helm guiding you (Ps 48v14). To think of someone dying without Jesus Christ as their Saviour is so tragic. They must live out their last moments in fear of the unknown, how sad that is.

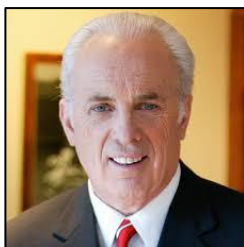

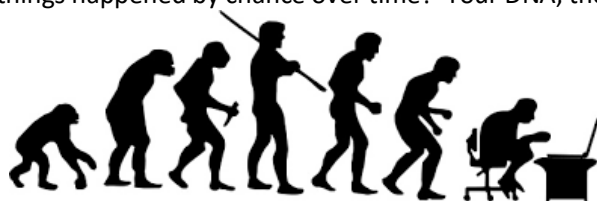
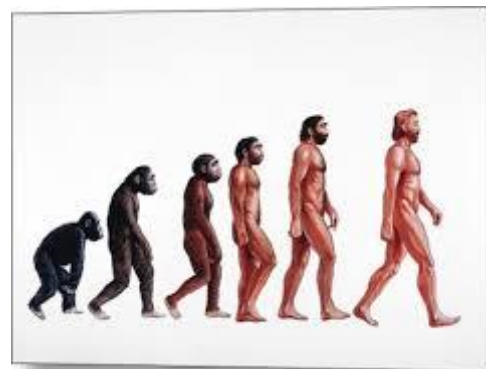
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Time for Truth!

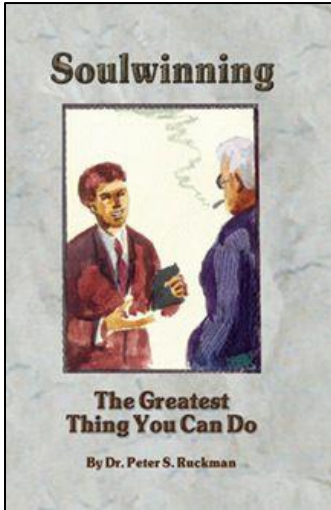

We would love to produce tens of thousands of these calendars, but more Christians would need to buy them for us to get the price down. Every church & Christian ought to be distributing Gospel calendars around their local areas.

It's YOUR responsibility!

If you don't try to win the people around YOU with the Gospel WHO WILL? Die without having your sins forgiven by Jesus Christ & WHERE will you go? You know... Hell. So why haven't you a passion & a burning desire to reach lost souls, trying to stop them from going to Hell? Today over 154,000 people will die. Where do you think the majority of them will go? How many people have you reached with the Gospel over this last year? You focused on a career instead? You were too engaged in buying a house, car, getting the kids into a 'decent-secular-school' (whatever that is!?) You wanted to travel & see the world before getting 'serious', you took a year out did you? In that year over 8,000,000 souls died & went somewhere! Where do you think the majority of them went? What are YOU doing about this horrific situation? When was the last time you bought some tracts & gave them out or posted them through house & business letterboxes? What have you been doing for the Lord in your life? You don't feel called I hear you say! EVERYONE is called to get the Gospel out in some way or other. I know of two elderly women who spend their pension posting out tracts to everyone in their local directories, makes you think doesn't it. What are YOU doing with 'God's' money? How much of your money goes into getting the Gospel out to sinners? Feel convicted? You should! If you don't, your backslidden & you didn't even realise it. **The backslider in heart shall be filled with his own ways!!!** Prov 14v14. That is SCRIPTURE dear friends, the words of God. **And seekest thou great things for thyself? seek them not:** Jer 45v5 – MORE SCRIPTURE! Are you a half-hearted Christian? Come on, own up, at least admit it, don't pretend & play games, are you with the Lord or not? Are you trying to live & please the Lord in everything or not, be honest with yourself just for once, or are you a lame, cowardly, lazy, apathetic Christian who just couldn't care less? YOU KNOW & God knows! You'll stand before Him soon, think about that – Rom 14v12. If you need to shake things up a bit, do so. If you need to make some radical changes in your life, NOW is the time! **And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed. The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light. Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying. But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof.** Rom 13v11-14. *(Please don't think watching & making YouTube videos all day is serving & living for the Lord, you've been duped by the Devil if you do! That will all get BURNT UP on Judgment day! - 1 Cor 3v13-15)*

They keep coming...

'Am I today less zealous for the Lord than I was 5/10 years ago?' If so why? You're backsliding! **The backslider in heart shall be filled with his own ways:** Prov 14v14 – are you? Are you reading the Scriptures & praying less or more today than you were? If it's not more, you're backsliding! Are you tracting more today than you once did, are you taking a stand for the Lord at your work place? If not, you're backsliding! Ps 25v18 **Look upon mine affliction and my pain; and forgive all my sins. Ps 86v5 For thou, Lord, art good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon thee.** Isn't it time you sorted your life out? Stop compromising, it's doing you no good at all, you are just living FOR the FLESH & ultimately the Devil. Stop what you are doing that is wrong & get your life back on track... TODAY... NOW!

If you are arrogant & full of pride, you're 'too big' for God to use, He's not interested in that kind of person. Beware of PRIDE, it will KILL your ministry, your gift & talent DEAD – Read Proverbs 6v16-19... or are you too proud?

Living Your Faith in the Workplace – by Allison Lewis

Living Your Faith At Work

As a Bible Believing Christian in a secular workplace it isn't easy, you are not going to fit in, so don't try to. Keep your testimony, and be a good employee. Serve The Lord, and avoid internal wranglings Ephesians 4v 29 .

Be transparent about your faith, don't try to hide it, 1 Peter 3v15 .

No man is an Island, you are an example to someone. The Apostle Paul is our example to follow, Titus 2v7&8. You ought to be the same in your home as you are in Church and also the same in your workplace. For to me to live is Christ and to die is gain. Philippians 1v21 .



Some Questions

1. Do your colleagues know you are a Christian?
2. Have you openly spoken about your faith or witnessed to a colleague?
3. Do your actions reflect your Christian principles? Colossians 3v17 .
4. Are you pursuing excellence in your workplace ? As unto The Lord, Colossians 3 v22&23 .

In my profession Nursing it is an ideal profession to incorporate and demonstrate God's love. In Care Homes I see people at the end of their lives, without God and without hope. Sometimes the T.V. is their only companion. They are watching you to see how you react, and in what manner you do things for them. Question : How do you react to people? Are you living honestly before people? Not cheating them, above reproach or at least trying to. Kindness and compassion go a long way for opening up opportunities to witness. I heard one Preacher say Charity is love with feet to it, its not just words or emotions, its the actions you put behind the affections or care of others. Hasn't The Lord shown kindness to you? Psalm 117.

Question: Do you treat people differently?

Do you love the unlovable?

Is every soul precious to you? Jesus died for all.

One of the first recollections I have of a Christian living out her faith in the workplace was a lady called Kath Gurnett, and this was in a pretty ungodly environment, it was in a large Psychiatric Hospital. I wasn't saved at the time but her boldness, kindness and the way she conducted herself impressed me. She would stand up for The Lord when His name was blasphemed and gently rebuke them saying He's my Saviour and He's precious to me, she witnessed to me on our breaks not on her employer's time, and everyone knew Kath was a Christian.

Remember someone is watching you. You may be the only Bible they read. Live out your faith at work. Pray for your colleagues to get saved and for openings to witness.

Quote: Nail your colours to the mast, that is the right thing to do, and therefore that is what we must do. The evangelisation of the unevangelised. C. T. Studd.

Abraham was a Gentile... RRB page 30

Gen 14v19 **And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth:** Note the expression 'the most high God'. This is a GENTILE designation (See Deut 32v8, Dan 3v26, 4v17+24 & Ps 9v2). Most people forget that Abraham was a GENTILE (Which he was until the passages on circumcision – Gen 17), which produced a seed that produces the NATION of Israel (called JEWS collectively in the New Testament, not just applicable to the tribe of Judah).

Great note from RRB...

Gen 15v3 **And Abram said, Behold, to me thou hast given no seed: and, lo, one born in my house is mine heir.** Abraham is promised '**the dust of the earth**' (Gen 13v16, coming from Ishmael), '**the sand of the sea**' (Gen 32v12, coming from Jacob as Israel), & '**the stars of heaven**' (Gen 26v4, a heavenly seed coming from Isaac, a type of Christ). The **dust** will match Ham, the **sand** will match Japheth, & the **stars** will match Shem, among Noah's sons. The **dust** will also match Cain, the **sand** will match Seth, & the **stars** will match Abel, in Adam's three sons.

Get this!

Gen 15v6 **And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.** This is quoted in Rom 4v3 & is the alibi for apostate Fundamentalists (e.g. fake-Pfenny) making Old Testament salvation the same as New Testament salvation – THEY ARE NOT! Abraham was NEVER circumcised spiritually, neither did he go to the THIRD heaven when he died; Abraham's sin was NOT taken away because Christ had NO BODY, & Abraham's justification took place more than TEN YEARS AFTER righteousness was imputed to him (cf. Gen 15 & Gen 22 – see also James 2v21+23).

Memorizing God's word by Jacob

Memorizing the word of God is a great way of keeping it on your mind constantly. It helps when engaging Satan when tempted with sin (Ps 119v11), combating spiritual apathy (Jeremiah 20v9), rejoicing a sad heart (Ps 19v8, 119v111, Jer 15v16), and being able to give the gospel to the lost (1 Pet 1v23-25), among many other things.

I wanted to give a few practical tips that you may find helpful for memorizing.

First off, I would encourage you to carry a copy of the word of God with you wherever you go, even if it's just a New Testament. However, there are many situations that we find ourselves in that having your Bible out is hard or impossible: the mechanic with grease up to the elbows working on a broken vehicle, the production line operator in a factory, the forklift driver in the warehouse, the Soldier on guard duty in the middle of the night, the mother trying to feed and care for several children all at once, etc, etc. In situations like these and many others, having Bible passages memorized are very helpful in keeping the mind "stayed on thee" and also for being able to present God's word to others in a conversation whether it's to encourage another Christian or to present the gospel to a lost person.



As for practical tips:

#1 BELIEVE that you've got help. The Author of The Book has promised to teach you and help you memorize this thing if you put forth some effort. John 14:26 says that God the Holy Ghost "shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you."

That's quite a promise. So know that as you try to work toward writing the old KJV on your heart, that you've got some serious help!

(And remember, He never promised to help you learn Shakespeare or the Gettysburg Address in grammar school, so if that was hard and you hated it, don't let that keep you from writing GOD'S WORDS on your heart!)

#2 WRITE IT DOWN somewhere. A notebook, a folded leaf of paper that you can keep about your person, index cards, the back of business cards, etc. work great. Post it where you'll see it. The bathroom mirror, in front of the kitchen sink, in your car, etc

It's interesting how many times God told someone to write down what he told them (for just one example, see Revelation 1v11 where the Lord told John "what thou seest, write...") Being that he's the One that "wired up" our brains, I think He knows that there's a connection between the pen in one's hand and the mind and heart. Probably any lost person in education would tell you the same thing.

Writing it down makes you slow down, think carefully on what you're writing, and adds another of the five senses to what you're doing (at a minimum, copying by hand uses the senses of "sight" and "touch", and "hearing" if you mutter out loud while you're writing it! If someone can incorporate "smell" and "taste" into this process please do let me know!)

#3 LISTEN to it. "Faith cometh by hearing", so having an mp3 recording or YouTube audio or scripture audiobook that you can listen to while you're driving or otherwise occupied can help you subconsciously memorize (Note: listening should be a supplement not a substitute for actually READING the Bible, health and eyesight permitting). There are some outstanding KJV ones on YouTube that you can listen to. A couple of my favourites are Alexander Scourby and Sir Laurence Olivier. Have you ever noticed how people that say "oh I can't memorize the Bible" are often the ones that can sing along with pop music on the radio and know every word to every Top 40 song from the last 30 years? Hearing is a very effective medium for memorizing, so why not use it for the Lord?

Also, the musicality of the Authorized Version King James text is unsurpassed by anything else on earth. It's made to be memorized and the Lord made it easy it with those beautiful, rhythmic, MEMORABLE, "words of eternal life".

#4 GET A FRIEND to "check" you on it. Handing a written down verse or passage to a friend and asking them to make sure that you don't get a single thing incorrect while quoting it back to them can be a fun encouragement to another believer and an incredible conversation starter if your friend happens to be lost.

Imagine working to memorize John 1v1-18 and then having a lost friend carefully read those words while listening to you quote them (sight and hearing!)? Think you could start a good conversation out of that? I bet you could.

Finally, let me challenge you with this:

In Matthew 4, Jesus quotes three passages to Satan upon being tempted. I think that three verses is a good, minimum rule of thumb to work toward for anything that you believe. Is Jesus Christ God? How many genders are there? Are there many ways to get to God? etc. Having at least three places where the Lord addresses these things and a host of others would be a good thing to work toward.

Also, imagine if you were thrown into prison for being a Christian. It has happened throughout history and continues through today and into the future.

If that happened to you, how much of God's word would you have to sustain you and those around you?

Isn't it time you tried again to reconcile?

Reconcile means to restore friendly relations between. Sort out your problems! If you have had a bust up with 'friend or family', then put it right, especially at this time of the year. Call, email, write a letter or send a card... but try!

Beware of FALSE teachers & preachers... It's a minefield out there!

Heb 13v9 **Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines.** Strange doctrines such as Hyper-Dispensationalism, Calvinism, Pentecostalism etc. 2 Pet 3v16 **As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction.** Hyper-Dispensationalists (Eddy-fake-Pfenny, Colic-Caldwell, Podgy-dodgy-Breaker etc.), Calvinists & Pentecostals ALL pull verses OUT OF CONTEXT to try to substantiate their heresies. You've got to be very aware that YouTube is full of preachers & teachers that teach heresy. There aren't many balanced Christians on there who are not narcissistic & 'love the camera'. Most are so full of fake humility, which is PRIDE, that God dumped them before they even got started, so don't you get caught up in their web of errors. BE CAREFUL who you watch & follow. It's a minefield out there, step on the wrong one & you'll certainly cause yourself some damage.



The lonely road of the Bible Believer – By Matt.



As a saved, born again Christian who believes the King James Bible is the perfect and infallible word of God, you enter into the minority of minorities. When you reject the modern Bible versions you will be branded a conspiracy theorist, a separatist and generally a tragically deceived and misinformed individual.

Those that hold to such beliefs are seen as a fringe group of radical wingnuts by the majority of professing Christendom today. Believing such a thing will put you at odds with the organised religious establishment, theological seminaries across the world, esteemed Bible "scholars" and other such vested interests.

Taking a stand for the authorised version will cost you something. This stance will lead to arguments, heartache, confrontation and hostilities. Such a conviction will cause you to leave Churches. You will be mocked and laughed out of seminaries. It will cause you to break fellowship with beloved friends and family members. You will question your own sanity.

Amo 3:3 **Can two walk together, except they be agreed?**

When all is said and done, the issue truly boils down to this. One of us is right and one of us is wrong.

Before making such a leap of faith, consider the evidence for yourself.

Trace the sources of the manuscripts back to their places of origin. Cross-reference scriptures between the King James Bible and those found in modern Bible versions. See what is missing. See what has been changed. Search for a perfect alternative. See who was involved in the translations of subsequent Bible versions and revisions. Pray and ask the Lord for truth. And then make a decision.

Is taking such a stance worth it? I believe so.

My faith has never been stronger. I trust my Bible from cover to cover and I have perfect assurance of my salvation.

1 John 5:13 **These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.**

Although I cannot hold a candle to the fruit seen in the lives of the brothers and sisters who have gone before me such as those brave souls of whom we read about in Foxe's Book of Martyrs, I have seen the fruit and the blessings the King James Bible has cultivated in my life and also in the lives of my Bible-Believing brothers and sisters in Christ.

So, to those brothers and sisters who are suffering persecution, who have no one else to have fellowship with and are finding yourselves isolated and alone;

Get a piece of paper & write down all the people you have helped this year... *feel convicted?* Have you done much to help others? 1 Cor 16v13-18 **Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong. Let all your things be done with charity. I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and that they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints,) That ye submit yourselves unto such, and to every one that helpeth with us, and laboureth. I am glad of the coming of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus: for that which was lacking on your part they have supplied. For they have refreshed my spirit and yours: therefore acknowledge ye them that are such.** The Body of Christ should be doing all it can to support & help one another, & those OUTSIDE of it, but are we. Are we so consumed by our own life that we are NOT looking after & looking out for others? Where is our Christian love? It's all very well getting your doctrine right, but without charity, without love, you're an empty vessel. *Make a change today!*

London, England's Capital

It's an absolute joke when the government tell us that crime is NOT getting any worse, it certainly is... everywhere! The number of killings in **London alone** in 2018 rose to its highest level for a decade, **130 homicides**. As of 17 December 2018, *most killings* in London involved **knives**. This is just ONE city here in beautiful England. That's how bad things have got. I read that there are 5 stabbings **a day** just in London, can you believe what is happening? All we can do is keep getting the Gospel out where we can & pray for God to have mercy upon us. Still feel empty in life?

You're a Christian but you *still* lack something in life? If you are NOT winning souls for the Lord Jesus Christ & getting actively involved in soul-winning, then you will feel empty. If you are NOT trying to impact other peoples lives for the Lord, you will feel like you're missing *something* in your life. Living for the Lord daily is the **ONLY** thing that really brings satisfaction & contentment (1 Tim 6v6, 1 Cor 15v58). I mean ask yourself this question... 'What am I *really* doing for the Lord?' Most Christians are doing very little if anything. Many Christians I know spend all their time doing things for **THEMSELVES!**

The Importance of Dispensationalism – by Michael Schreib

The idea of *Dispensationalism*, as an approach to learning the Bible, comes from Paul's instruction to his own disciple Timothy, "**Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.**" (2 Timothy 2:15)

He tells his trusted follower (and us by extension) WHAT he is supposed to do: "**Study**"

He tells him WHY he is supposed to do it: to be "**approved unto God,**" and "**not to be ashamed.**"

Then he tells him HOW he is supposed to do it: by "**rightly dividing the word of truth.**"

Christians who are "lazy" (my new abbreviation for *Laodicean*) have decided that spiritual light should come to them quickly, with little effort on their part (Remember how long it took your grandmother to bake potatoes in the oven? Fortunately, we have microwaves now!). Thus they have been drawn to a multitude of modern translations, none of which tell them to "**study**" [e.g. "Do your best" (ESV), "Concentrate on doing your best" (*The Message*, paraphrase), "Do your best" (NIV), etc.] None of the new-improved-updated-modernized "versions" tell the reader to do just one simple thing: "**study.**" They hated to study in school, so why should they study in church? or at home? or at work? In fact, this aversion to study is so pronounced that modern churches don't offer Sunday "school" any longer. It's "Kid's Church," "Junior Jamboree," "Faith and FUN," "Teen Talk," and even the "Sexy Single Seniors." One modern version tried to straddle the subject by saying "Do your best *and* study" (*Amplified Version*, italics in the original).

But your "best" is dubious. Especially in light of Isaiah's reminder that "**all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags**" (Isaiah 64:6), and the Apostle Paul considered his best to be "**dung**" (Philippians 3:8). Also, "**The thoughts of the diligent (the student) tend only to plenteousness; but of every one that is hasty (the do-your-bester) only to want.**" (Prov 21:5) Not only is the phrase "do your best" ambiguous, so also is the reminder to "handle accurately the true word" as found in the modern renditions. For whatever it's worth, the Greek verb translated as "rightly dividing" is *ορθοτομειω* (*orthotomeo*), and its inarguable definition is to "make a straight cut; to correctly dissect." Thus, the Authorized Version has the language right, while the others are plainly wrong.

But back to our subject of Dispensationalism. Anyone reading the scriptures for the first time will immediately see an Old Testament and a New Testament. The natural question is, "What, if any, are the differences between them?" One who is Dispensational (who believes in "**rightly dividing**") will try to understand the several divisions found throughout the Bible. Even faithful Christians can forget that before Christ's death, His public ministry was still under the Old Testament requirements of the Law. There was no Church yet.

The English word *dispensation* comes from 14th century French, *dispenser* (to "give out"), following a 13th century Latin word *dispensare* ("disburse, distribute, pay out, and administer"). The English word is plain enough from its root, to "dispense" something. But WHAT is God dispensing? Chiefly, He is dispensing some new revelation of Himself, and His instructions as pertaining to righteousness.

A dispensational Christian realizes that not everything he reads in the scriptures is intended for him personally. A fellow once told my grandfather, "I believe all the promises in the Bible can be claimed by Christians today," to which he replied, "That's impossible. What about Luke 1:31? '**And behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.**' That was a promise to someone, but not to YOU!"

Consider, Adam and his wife had no knowledge of sin yet, and only one command to obey, AVOID the forbidden tree. Their disobedience brought about a revelation of the conscience for the first time.

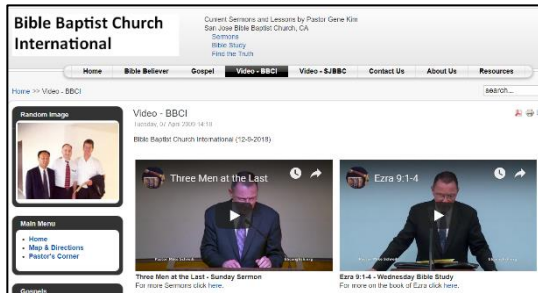
Noah, with that conscience of good and evil, was commanded to build an Ark in order to save his household. And after surviving, received the revelation pertaining to human government (Genesis 9:4-6)

Abraham was expected to believe God's promise about fathering a son in his old age. When he finally did, and obeyed God's further command concerning his son (Genesis 22), the Lord "**counted it to him for righteousness**" (Genesis 15:6).

Historic timeframes locating where one "dispensation" ends, and another one begins can sometimes be arbitrary, but the attempt at "**rightly dividing**" is to be encouraged. Dr. Ruckman succinctly observed that "Time brackets show up where alterations in method and protocol take place" (*How to teach Dispensational Truth*, pg. 9). John Darby identified SEVEN dispensations between Genesis-Revelation. Likewise Scofield, SEVEN. Bullinger, SEVEN, W.C. Bayne (1808-1887) saw THREE, Charles Hodge (1797-1878) had FOUR. A clear example of why "**rightly dividing**" is so important can be seen between the period of the Old Testaments' Law, and the New Testaments' salvation by Grace through Faith.

Moses told the children of Israel, "**And it shall be OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS, if we observe TO DO all these commandments before the Lord our God, AS HE HATH COMMANDED US**" (Deuteronomy 6:24-25) Their "righteousness" would be measured by the degree of their obedience to the Law, and doing what they were told. John the Baptist's parents Zacharias and Elisabeth (still living in Old Testament times), knew this: "**And they were both RIGHTEOUS before God, (how?) walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless**" (Luke 1:6). But this standard had to be maintained until death, or all would be lost. "**But when the righteous turneth away from his righteousness ... and doeth according to all the abominations that the wicked man doeth, shall he live? All his righteousness that he hath done shall not be mentioned ... in his trespass ... and in his sin ... in them shall he die.**" (Ezekiel 18:24) Yet, Isaiah's sobering words remained, "**...all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags**" (Isaiah 64:6).

Now, contrast all of that with Paul’s declaration, “**Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us...**” (Titus 3:5) “**For by grace are ye saved ... not of works**” (Eph 2:8-9). He recognized that a new “protocol” was in place, “**For they (Israel) ... going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God.**” New revelation: “**For Christ is THE END of the law FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS to every one that believeth**” (Romans 10:3-4). Without accepting the truth of dispensations, and “**rightly dividing**” the Bible, there would be endless “contradictions.” Following the “dispensation” of the Law, and this present “dispensation” of God’s Grace, the future Tribulation will be a “dispensation” combining both Law and Grace, Faith and Works (See Revelation 12:11, 17, 14:12). James 2:20 will finally be literally applied, “**But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?**” A dispensational approach is as important to the Bible believing student as clean air is to the lungs.

 Num 5v3 **Both male and female shall ye put out, without the camp shall ye put them; that they defile not their camps, in the midst whereof I dwell.**
 Mat 19v4 **And he answered and said unto them, Have ye not read, that he which made them at the beginning made them male and female,**
 Mark 10v6 **But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female.**

- 4) I cannot stand the way our country has gone so far downhill regarding morals, traditions & authority, all because we have departed from THE BOOK & we have such a useless ANTI-Christian government. The corrupt ANTI-Christian media who are habitual liars have only fuelled the fire.
