Young British paratrooper Bill Harris and nursing student Anne Linton ask these and other questions every day as they serve God and their country during World War II.

After Bill becomes a prisoner of war, the young couple experience unimaginable trials of faith. They must hold on to the promise that joy will come in the morning, even though it seems as if there is little hope for tomorrow.
